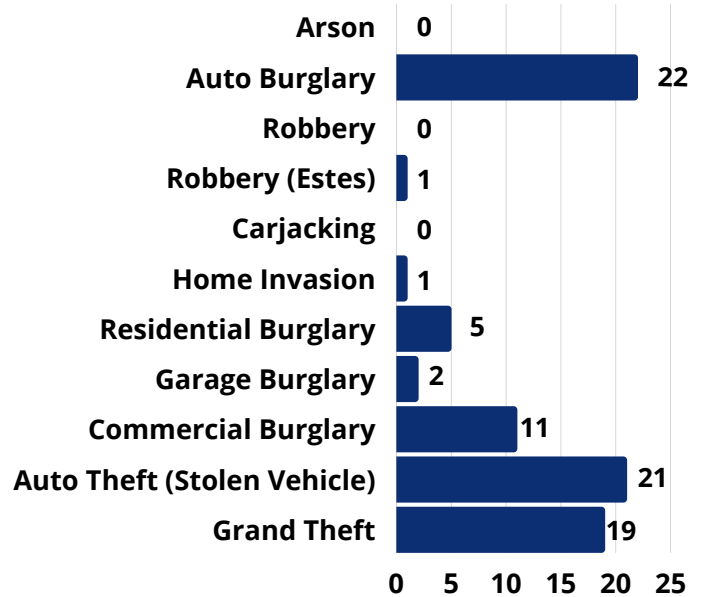

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 6/16, officers responded to the Warm Springs Blvd and S Grimmer Blvd area after two victims reported that they were attacked by a subject armed with a baseball bat. The two victims advised that the attack was unprovoked, and the subject struck them with a baseball bat resulting in minor injuries. Officers responded immediately and located the subject. The adult subject out of Fremont was arrested without incident. #230616003

Battery

On 6/19, officers responded to a battery near a liquor store on Thornton Ave. Witnesses reported seeing a male and female in a physical altercation inside a vehicle parked near the store. The female victim exited the vehicle, and the male subject gave chase on foot, held, and choked the victim. The male subject then returned to the vehicle and drove away. Officers located the subject and his vehicle nearby and arrested the subject. #230619009

On 6/16, officers responded to a pharmacy on Mowry Ave; a subject entered, battered an employee, and fled the store. Officers flooded the area and checked neighboring businesses looking for the subject. Officers located the subject at the BART Station. The subject was positively identified by the victim and arrested. #230616039

Commercial Burglary

On 6/15, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a hardware store on Mowry Ave. The reporting party advised that the subject entered a moving van. Detectives were in the area and saw the vehicle leaving the parking lot. Additional units arrived, including ALCO Air Services, which assisted in maintaining vehicle surveillance. Officers and ALCO Air conducted a vehicle stop and later determined that the vehicle was not involved in the burglary. This case remains under investigation. #230613030

On 6/18, officers responded to a used auto retailer on Christy St after a security monitoring service observed several masked subjects cutting a hole in a fence. The suspects gained entry into the car lot and stole two SUVs. As officers approached the area, the subjects rammed the gates, exited the lot, and were last seen fleeing northbound on Christy St at a high rate of speed. This case remains under investigation. #230618006

Home Invasion Robbery

On 6/14, officers responded to a residence on Elk Ct after the victim advised that two masked subjects wearing all dark clothing broke into her residence, battered her, and stole jewelry. The subjects then fled the area in a passenger vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #230615024

Grand Theft/Stolen Firearm

On 6/16, officers responded to the report of a found firearm near Coco Palm and Blacow Rd. They located a gun that was reported stolen the night before. On 6/15, a reporting party called to advise that her ex-boyfriend came into her home and stole her registered gun. This case remains under investigation. #230616040

Trespassing

On 6/19, officers responded to a high school in Irvington to a report of juveniles on the roof of a campus building. Along with trespassing, the juveniles destroyed glass and poured chemicals from a science lab. Officers arrived and contacted the juveniles. The group was ultimately reprimanded and released. School officials will be determining consequences for the juveniles. HAZMAT responded to dispose of the chemical safely. #230619019

Other Incidents

On 6/16, officers responded to a possible arson at the corner of Moraine St and Thornton Ave after a reporting party witnessed a subject pouring kerosene into a pot and lighting it on fire. The reporting party was concerned due to nearby dry grass and other flammables. Officers arrived and had the subject extinguish the fire. The subject stated he was trying to make coffee. Officers generously purchased coffee for the subject so he would not be tempted to light any more fires. #P23068398

On 6/17, officers responded to the report of a subject swinging a machete near Blacow Rd and Thornton Ave. Officers were initially unable to locate the subject but later came across the subject walking into Fremont from Newark. Officers evaluated the subject and found him to be under the influence of a controlled substance. One adult subject out of Fremont was arrested. #230617025
