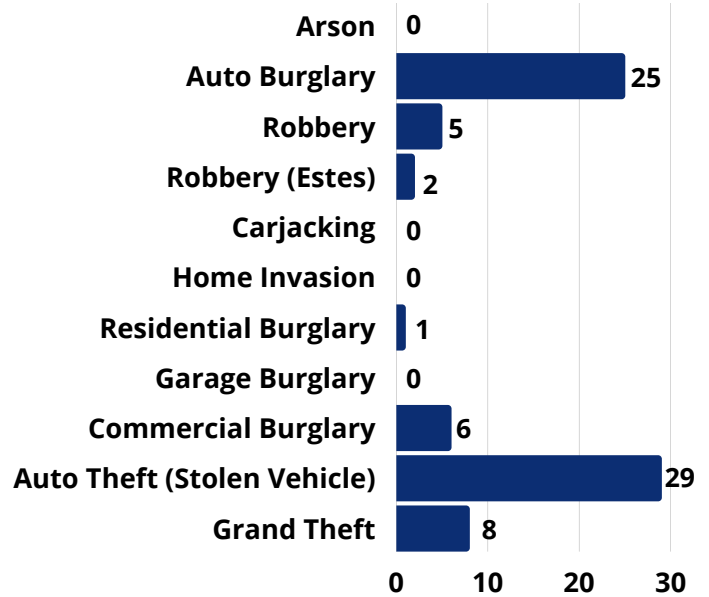

Aggravated Trespassing

In the early morning of 7/20, officers responded to a call from a resident at Mandan Pl who reported hearing someone inside her residence. She was alone with her child and saw someone sleeping on her living room couch. Officers formulated a contact team and removed the victim and her child without waking the subject. Officers then arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont. #230720003

Armed Robbery

On 7/18, officers responded to a community member who said two subjects had entered his vehicle while parked in a drugstore parking lot. The subjects brandished a knife and told the victim to drive to the area of Lakeview Blvd. During the drive, the subjects took cash and a non-operating cell phone. Once they arrived near Lakeview Blvd, the subjects exited the vehicle and fled on foot. During the investigation, officers discovered that the crime originated in Milpitas. Milpitas PD responded and resumed the investigation. #230718047

On 7/22, two subjects entered a convenience store near Fremont Blvd and Blacow Rd. They pointed firearms at the clerk, threatened to shoot, and demanded money from the register. The subjects took cash and fled in a vehicle. The case remains under investigation. #230722006

On 7/20, a victim in the 4700 block of Mendocino Ter confronted and chased two subjects who were burglarizing his vehicle. The subjects brandished firearms and yelled at the victim, dissuading him from further pursuit. The victim lost multiple power tools, and the burglary caused significant damage to the vehicle. The case remains under investigation. #230720010

Bank Robbery

On 7/22, officers responded to a silent hold-up alarm at a bank on Mowry Ave. The subject had used a note to demand money from the teller and threatened those inside. The subject took about \$200 in cash and exited the building. The case remains under investigation. #230722018

Battery

On 7/20, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Mission Blvd for a battery involving a customer (subject) and the manager. The subject was upset over the perception that the manager had not washed his hands. The subject used offensive words and threw a water bottle at the manager twice. The manager and another worker were injured. The subject, an adult out of Stockton, was arrested. #230720030

Brandishing a Weapon/Hit and Run/Stolen Vehicle

On 7/23, dispatch received a report from a victim driving near Mowry Ave and Peralta Blvd that a passenger in another vehicle pointed a handgun at her. As officers responded to this call, another party reported being chased by a similar-looking vehicle, with the subjects inside throwing objects, screaming obscenities, and sideswiping the victim's vehicle. Eventually, the subjects crashed into the victim's vehicle. The victim reported seeing three juvenile subjects, including one armed with a handgun, flee on foot near Driftwood Dr and Briarwood Dr. Officers located and apprehended the three subjects at an apartment complex on Glenmoor Dr. The involved vehicle was stolen from a nearby City earlier that morning, and the handgun seen by reporting parties was determined to be a BB gun. #230723020

Commercial Burglary

On 7/23, dispatch received an alarm call about a subject who had forced entry into an empty commercial building on Osgood Rd. Officers arrived and saw the subject flee into the building, with stolen property staged near the door. Officers located the subject, an adult out of San Jose, and arrested him. #230723003

Warrant Service

On 7/19, officers responded to the Fremont Main Library regarding an adult subject who had returned to the library after being given a suspension letter. The reporting party stated that the subject had threatened her and refused to leave. The subject also had a felony warrant. Officers located the subject watching explicit adult videos on a public computer and arrested him. Before being transported to jail, the subject said he wished to self-harm. The subject was cleared at Washington Hospital and taken to Santa Rita Jail. #230719031 and #230719034
