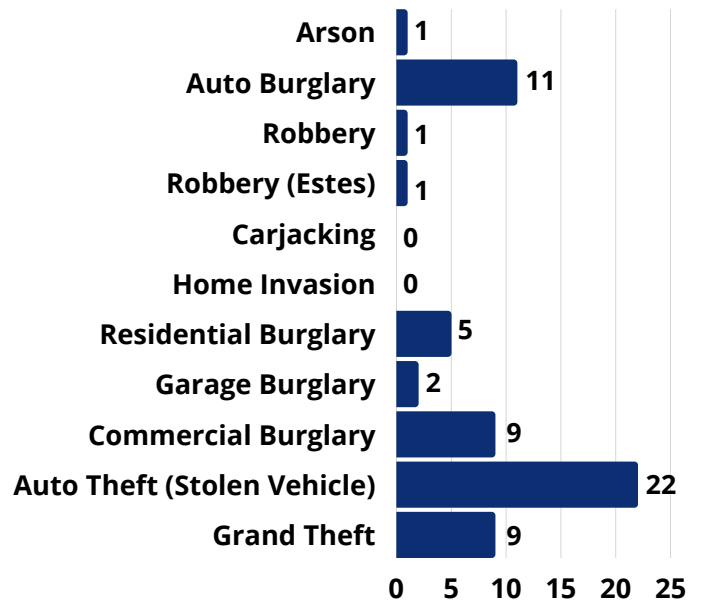

Armed Robbery

On 8/22, officers responded to an armed robbery at a convenience store on Fremont Blvd. The clerk advised that a subject had brandished a knife while stealing beer. Officers located the subject riding away from the area on a bicycle. The subject resisted but was eventually detained and arrested. #230822046

On 8/23, officers followed up on an armed robbery that had occurred at a massage parlor on Warm Springs Blvd on 8/14. Officers discovered the subject had committed multiple armed robberies at various massage parlors in the Bay Area. In Oakland, officers located the subject, an adult out of San Leandro, and arrested him. #230814043

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 8/23, officers responded to a residence on Audrey Ct where a subject had stabbed his domestic partner (victim) during an argument. Small children were inside the residence, so officers separated the subject from the children and made verbal contact with the subject. The victim and subject were transported for medical clearance, and officers later arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont. #230823004

Domestic Violence

On 8/25, officers met with an individual (victim) in the police department lobby who reported that her domestic partner (subject) had battered her, causing visible injuries. After the interview and additional investigative steps, officers contacted the subject and arrested him, an adult out of Fremont. #230825023

Fatal Traffic Collision

Reckless Fire

On 8/27, officers observed a subject lighting a shopping cart full of garbage on fire near a bank on Mission Blvd. Fremont Fire Department responded to extinguish the fire, and officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont. #230827013

Resisting a Police Officer

On 8/26, officers received a report that a subject at a gas station on Auto Mall Pkwy was waving a firearm in the air. As officers were en route, he drove away. Officers patrolled the area and located the subject nearby. Upon being ordered to surrender, the subject jumped back into his vehicle and drove away, traveling on I-880 at a high speed. On 8/28, Tracy Police located the subject while responding to a call for service and arrested him, an adult out of Hayward. #230826010

Sexual Assault

On 8/23, officers received a report from a victim who was sexually assaulted near Fremont Blvd and Monroe Ave. While giving the victim a ride home, the subject disrobed, stripped the victim of his clothing, and attempted to assault him sexually. The victim escaped from the vehicle and used a rideshare service to get home. This case remains under investigation. #230823012

Vandalism

On 8/26, officers responded to a residence on Sequoia Rd after receiving a report of a subject attempting to force open one of the windows on a neighbor's vehicle. Officers located the subject and found that he had also vandalized the vehicle. The subject, an adult out of Fremont, was arrested and taken to a hospital for medical clearance. #230826006

Warrant Service

On 8/24, officers responded to a report of a disturbance at a restaurant on Thornton Ave. The subject had refused to leave and threatened to burn the building down. Officers found that she had an outstanding warrant and arrested the woman, an adult, out of Fremont. #230824020
