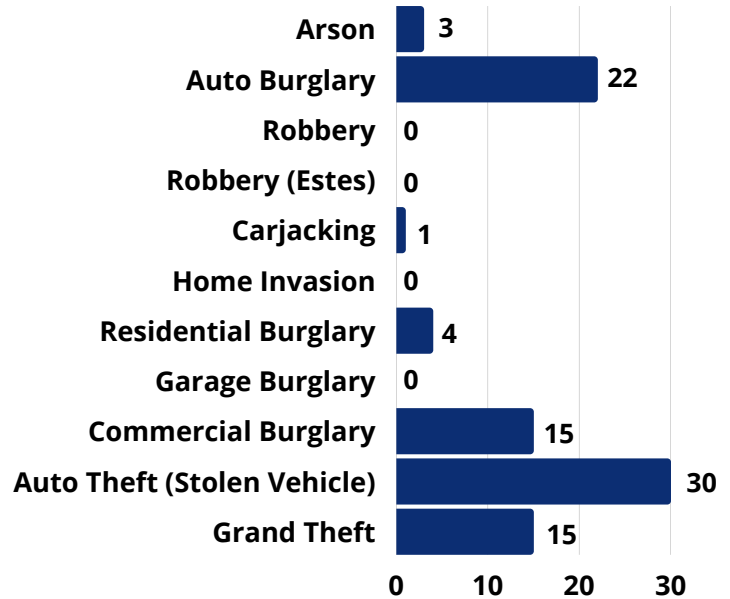




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Arson

On 10/7, officers responded to the Fremont Blvd and Washington Blvd area regarding a planter box that had been lit on fire. When officers arrived, the fire had been put out, but a subject nearby confessed to starting it. Officers arrested the subject, an adult, out of Fremont. #231007019

On 10/9, officers responded to two motorcycles that had been set on fire near Bell St. Fremont Fire Department was present when officers arrived and had already put the fire out. No physical evidence at the scene indicated how it had been caused. This case remains under investigation. #231009044

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 10/4, officers responded to a stabbing at an apartment complex on Central Ave. The victim said his wife (subject) had stabbed him multiple times. Upon arrival, officers detained the subject and provided care to the victim. The victim was transported to a hospital for treatment, and officers arrested the subject. #231004011

## Attempted Carjacking

On 10/3, officers responded to an attempted carjacking in the Sundale Dr and Wall Common area. The two subjects fled on foot to an apartment complex, and a shelter-in-place protocol was initiated at a nearby elementary school. Both subjects were eventually taken into custody without incident. ## Auto Theft

On 10/7, a caller reported to Union City Police Department that his vehicle had been stolen. Shortly afterward, his vehicle was seen disabled on Mowry Ave and Fremont Blvd, and another caller advised that five juvenile subjects had fled the vehicle on foot. Officers apprehended two juveniles running through the Fremont Hub, one carrying a loaded firearm. One subject was booked at the Juvenile Justice Center; the other was cited and released to a family member. This case remains under investigation. #231007012

## Battery

On 10/3, a victim was driving on Bay St when a subject threw a metal chair at his vehicle. When the victim stopped to confront the subject, the subject battered him. When officers arrived, the subject retreated into his apartment but eventually came outside and surrendered. The subject was detained and transported to a hospital. #231003028

## Felony Warrant Arrest

On 10/3, officers located a subject from a previous sexual assault case who now had a felony warrant for sexual assault. Officers convinced the subject to come out of his house and arrested him. #231003032

## Reckless Fire

On 10/5, officers responded to multiple reports of a subject setting fires in a field near the 41000 block of Roberts Ave. Officers arrested the subject, an adult out of Fremont, and Fremont Fire Department extinguished the moderate brush fire. #231005045

## Sexual Battery

On 10/3, officers responded to a report of attempted rape at a residence on Aiken Ct. The homeowner rents out several rooms, and one of the renters (subject) entered another tenant's (victim) room and sexually battered her. Officers responded and detained the subject, an adult out of Fremont. #231003031

On 10/6, officers responded to a report of sexual battery at Lake Elizabeth. The reporting party was walking the lake with her baby and dog when a subject walked up and grabbed her inappropriately. Officers responded and arrested the subject, an adult out of Newark. #231006014

## Vandalism

On 10/4, officers responded to a report of a subject yelling and punching vehicles in a hotel parking lot on Cushing Pkwy. The subject broke a window to a hotel room with a rock, then fled on foot. Officers located the subject and arrested him, an adult out of Fremont. #231004042
