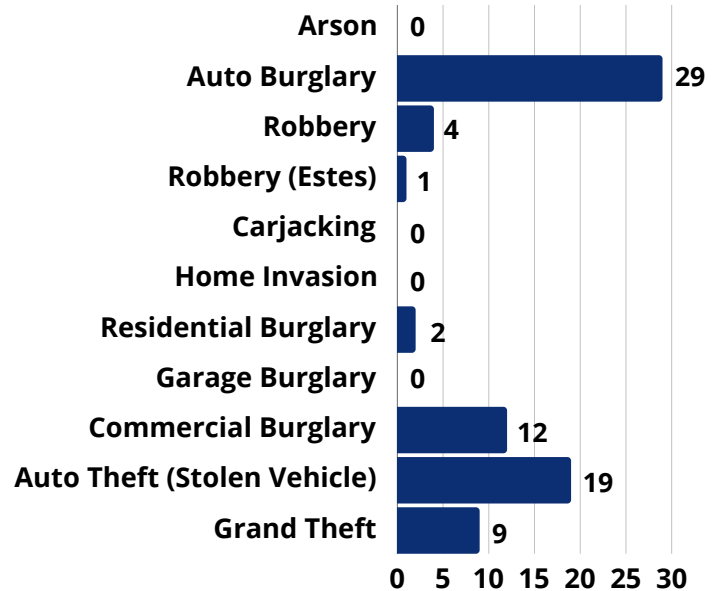

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 2/21, a victim reported that a subject had hit him in the face with a wine bottle at an apartment complex on Mowry Ave. The subject and victim were in dispute over ownership of a vehicle. #240221006

On 2/23, officers responded to an assault near Stewart Ave and Christy St. The victim and subject were in a dispute when the subject struck the victim on the head with a bat. The subject fled before officers arrived, and the victim was transported for non-life-threatening injuries. This case remains under investigation. #240223033

Battery/Hate Crime

On 2/25, multiple callers reported a battery incident near a café on Mowry Ave. Unprovoked, a subject struck a woman and punched a young child who crossed his path as he was fleeing. The subject also made ethnic slurs during the assaults. After a brief foot pursuit, officers arrested the subject. #240225013

Mental Health Hold

On 2/23, a victim reported that a subject threw a brick and other items at his truck while he was driving near Stewart Ave and Christy St. When the victim exited the vehicle, the subject continued to throw items and battered the victim. Officers arrested the subject and placed her on a mental health hold. #240223011

Outside Assist

On 2/20, security at a college contacted a vehicle in the college's parking garage on Pine St. During the investigative stop, security located four juveniles, a large amount of marijuana, scales, and a loaded firearm. Officers responded to assist with processing the firearm and detaining the subjects. The subjects were released to their parents. #240220040

On 2/24, dispatch broadcast that California Highway Patrol units were pursuing a vehicle believed to have been carjacked in a nearby city. Officers found the vehicle traveling near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Durham Rd and initiated a pursuit. The subjects eventually fled on foot. Two subjects were immediately taken into custody, and the others began hopping into backyards. Officers contained the area and apprehended both subjects in the backyards. An additional subject was located under a vehicle on a nearby street. #240225001

Possession of a Stolen Firearm

On 2/23, a caller reported a subject looking into several vehicles on Soapberry Common. When confronted, the subject resisted the officer's commands and ducked between two vehicles. He was eventually stopped and detained, and a search revealed a firearm he had discarded. The firearm was discovered as stolen out of another county. The subject was arrested. #240223020

Robbery

On 2/23, a department store on Christy St called to report that they had a subject in custody for shoplifting. The subject had left the store with several items of stolen merchandise. When confronted, the subject pushed loss prevention personnel in an attempt to escape. The subject was previously issued a trespass notice and was not allowed into the department store. Officers arrived and arrested the subject. #240223036

On 2/25, a victim reported being robbed at gunpoint on Civic Center Dr. While the victim was performing his duties at work, the subject pointed a gun at him, pushed him to the ground, and held him down while he took the victim's phone. The subject demanded the victim's phone password, then tied him up and locked him inside a restroom. After the attack, the victim discovered that someone had bought several thousands of dollars worth of cryptocurrency on one of his accounts. This case remains under investigation. #240225016

Shots Fired

On 2/20, officers responded to a shooting at a motel on Cushing Pkwy. Upon arrival, officers discovered the room abandoned, with a broken window and two bullet holes in the door. Motel guests said they saw a subject banging on the motel room door just before gunshots were heard. The room was empty at the time of the shooting, but a search of the room revealed a loaded firearm and evidence of drug activity. This case remains under investigation. #240220022
