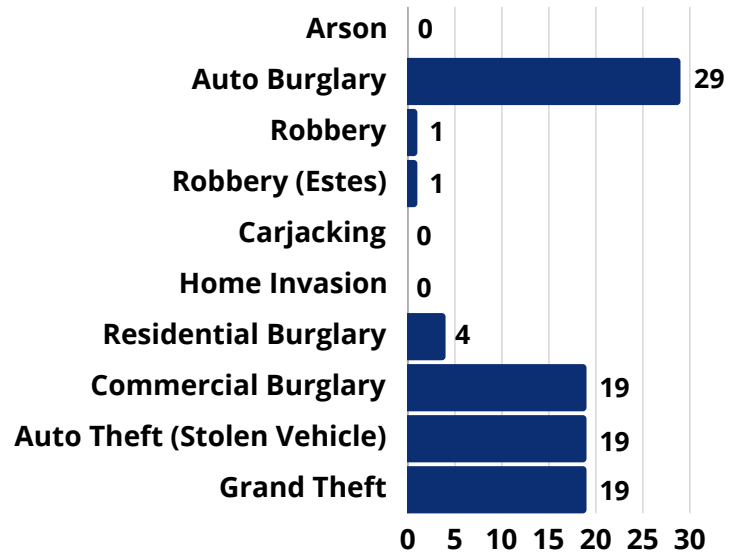




Fremont Police Week In Review

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 3/31, a tow truck driver (victim) was responding to a call from a senior housing facility on Fremont Blvd after a resident found an unauthorized vehicle in her parking space. The driver (subject) of the unauthorized vehicle was confrontational when asked to move his vehicle. After a verbal altercation with the victim, the subject hit the victim multiple times with a stick. The subject grabbed a gun from his waistband and pointed it at the victim while threatening him. He took the keys to the tow truck and drove away. This case remains under investigation. #240331019

On 4/1, officers responded to a park on Country Dr regarding a fight involving several juveniles. One struck a vehicle with a bat and broke the windshield, and another struck a juvenile with a crowbar. Some of the juveniles fled the area in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240401025

Battery on a Police Officer

On 4/1, a subject was walking in traffic near Fremont Blvd and Thornton Ave when an officer attempted to stop him. The subject became upset and combative and was eventually taken into custody. He bit one officer on the leg and spat on another. Officers arrested the subject. #240401029

Brandishing a Weapon

On 3/31, officers responded to a restaurant on Albrae St regarding two subjects who had brandished a firearm. The victim said he was driving his family and was turning their vehicle into the parking lot when two subjects in a vehicle cut him off. The subject vehicle sped down the row and nearly hit the victim's son, who was walking across the parking lot. The victim and subjects stopped next to one another and began arguing through their windows. The subjects exited the vehicle, and one grabbed a firearm from the trunk. He pointed it toward the victim and his family, who ran inside the restaurant to hide. The subjects fled in their vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240331020

Robbery

On 3/27, officers responded to a department store on Christy St regarding a robbery. One subject was using wire cutters to remove the security tags from purses, while a second subject stood lookout. The victim confronted the subjects and was cut by the wire cutters as he attempted to retrieve the purses. The subjects fled in a vehicle but were captured on video. Officers identified the subject, who had been cutting security tags, and obtained a warrant for his arrest. #240327014

Grand Theft

On 3/26, officers investigated three reports of grand theft throughout the city. Two subjects stole jewelry from elderly victims in three separate incidents. The subjects swapped the victims' real jewelry for fake jewelry. In all three incidents, the subjects matched the same description. This case remains under investigation. #240326009, #240326028, and #240326033

Shots Fired (Reported)

On 3/28, officers responded to a reported shooting in the State St and Capitol Ave area. One motorist (victim) said another motorist (subject) had fired shots during a road rage incident. The victim and subject vehicles were seen on camera pursuing each other in the area, but no crime scene could be located. #240328007

Traffic Collision

On 3/27, officers responded to a rollover collision at the intersection of Fremont Blvd and Cushing Pkwy. Officers found the vehicle on its side with a subject trapped inside. Officers used their patrol vehicle to prevent the vehicle from rolling further. The subject was eventually extricated from the vehicle and treated by Fremont Fire Department. #240327012

Vandalism

On 3/27, officers responded to a residence on Paseo Padre Pkwy after a victim advised that her son (subject) was on his way to vandalize her property. The victim said the subject called and said he was on his way to destroy the house and would be there in two minutes. He arrived before officers and began kicking the front door, causing damage. The subject left before officers arrived. #240327007
