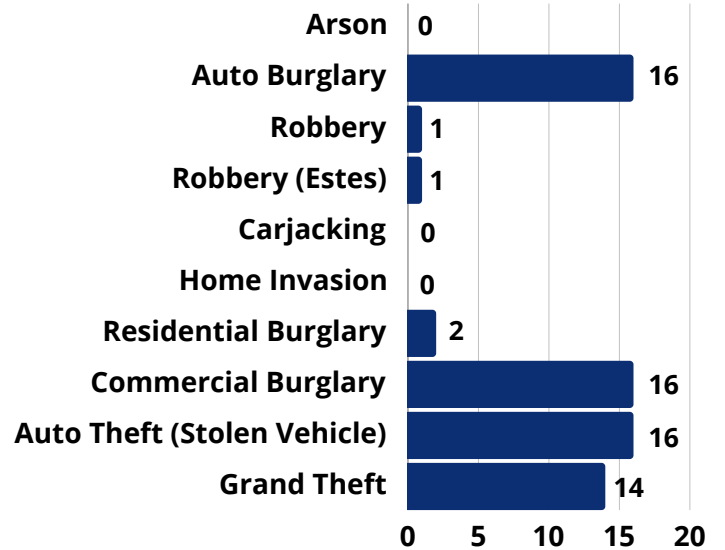

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/12, a large fight involving 50 juveniles was reported at a restaurant near Irvington High School. At one point, a juvenile threw a chair at another. The crowd dispersed before police arrived, and no victims were located. #P24043296

Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Auto Burglary

On 4/9, three subjects were reported fighting in the middle of the roadway at Warm Springs Blvd and Mission Blvd. One subject was on the ground being choked. Investigation revealed that the subject smashed the window and stole from a parked car outside a restaurant nearby. The car owner and an employee of the business confronted the subject, who assaulted the car owner with a burglary tool. A prolonged fight began between the three of them, but the subject was eventually controlled, and officers arrested him after arriving. #240409040

Brandishing a Firearm/Criminal Threats

On 4/15, officers responded to an apartment on Stevenson Blvd regarding two victims who said a subject had approached them and began arguing with them. He pointed a firearm at them, threatening to shoot and kill them. He then left in a vehicle. Upon arrival at the apartment, officers saw the subject inside, attempting to run out of the rear patio. Officers surrounded the apartment and eventually convinced the subject to exit the apartment. He was arrested, and the apartment was secured. #240415049

Hit and Run/DUI

On 4/9, an officer was stopped at a red light on Stevenson Blvd and Paseo Padre Pkwy when he witnessed a collision between a vehicle and a motorcycle. The motorcyclist sustained minor injuries. The vehicle fled, but the officer located the driver. He was found to be intoxicated and was arrested. #240409039

Making a False Police Report

On 4/10, officers responded to a subject who said her neighbor had attempted to stab her with a knife at a residence on Pardee Ave. The subject and neighbor were in a dispute, and the subject attempted to stop the neighbor's hired workers from building a fence between their properties. Investigation revealed that the subject was lying to officers, and the knife in question was actually a shoe that the neighbor was gesturing with. The subject was arrested. #240410030

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 4/9, dispatch received a report of a subject who had a substantial amount of blood on his shirt near Fremont Blvd and Papazian Way. The subject had discarded a knife and was walking toward a homeless encampment. When officers contacted him, the subject denied stabbing anyone and was uninjured. He claimed he was recently in a fistfight. No victims were located, and the knife the subject discarded had no blood on it. Officers discovered drug paraphernalia on the subject and arrested him. #240409037

Possession of a Stolen Vehicle

On 4/9, officers responded to a gas station on Mowry Ave regarding a stolen vehicle. A subject had asked the reporting party not to call the police on the subject's vehicle because it was stolen. Upon arrival, officers confirmed that it was stolen and arrested the subject. #240409016

Public Intoxication

On 4/11, officers responded to a mobile home park on Deep Creek Rd regarding an intoxicated subject in the community complex. The subject was smashing his phone because it wasn't working. He was unable to answer questions and was having difficulty walking. Officers arrested the subject. #240411027

Shots Fired

On 4/10, officers responded to a shooting at an apartment complex on Central Ave. The reporting party was returning from work when she heard multiple gunshots and saw two subjects jump into a vehicle and drive away. Witnesses said the subjects fired multiple rounds into the air before fleeing. Officers located several shell casings at the scene. No tenants or community members were found with any gunshot wounds or injuries. #240410001
