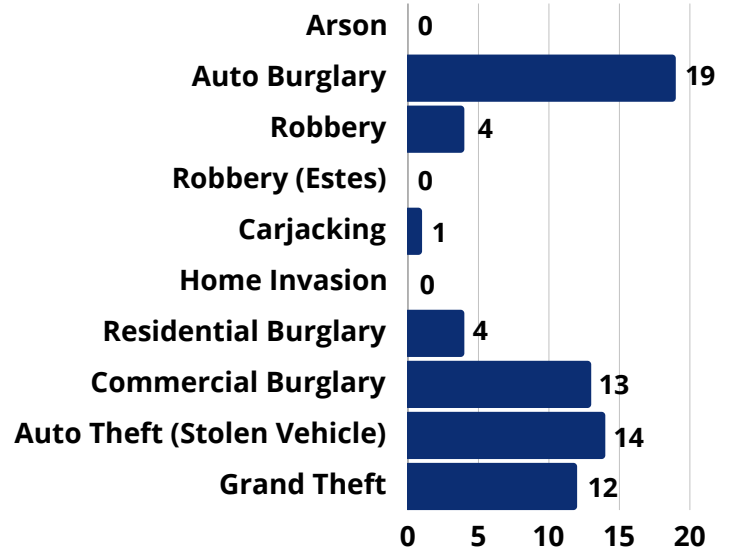

Battery

On 4/18, officers responded to a report of employees fighting at a factory on Fremont Blvd after a subject quit and was told to leave the property. The subject punched an employee and resisted security, who pinned him to the ground until officers arrived. Officers arrested the subject. #240418033

Brandishing a Weapon

On 4/16, officers responded to a report of an assault in front of the Fremont Main Library. The subject confronted two victims and demanded a cigarette from them. When they refused, the subject produced a knife and punched one victim. The victim punched the subject in return, and the subject fled. Officers arrested him when he was found hiding behind a tree at a bank on Walnut Ave. #240416021

Burglary

On 4/17, officers responded to a report of a burglary at a gymnastics studio on Davenport Pl. Two subjects entered the back of the business via an open door, grabbed cash and credit cards, and left. The subjects charged approximately \$15,000 on the cards. This case remains under investigation. #240417020

Carjacking

On 4/20, officers responded to a report of a carjacking on Enterprise Pl. A subject with a baseball bat and stun gun was attempting to steal the victim's vehicle. The victim confronted the subject and tried to turn the vehicle off, but the subject used the stun gun on him. The victim then opened the hood and removed the battery. The subject brandished a baseball bat at the victim, then exited the victim's vehicle and fled in his own vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #240420021

Drunk in Public

On 4/17, officers responded to an apartment complex on Bronson St regarding a subject who was breaking car windows and screaming. The subject was found intoxicated and unable to care for himself. Officers arrested the subject. #240417002

Grand Theft

On 4/18, officers investigated a grand theft at a construction site near Sennett Ter and Cinematic Common. Subjects had removed electrical wiring from homes under construction, causing a loss of approximately \$14,000. This case remains under investigation. #240418034 and #240418035

Peeping

On 4/16, dispatch received several reports of a subject holding what appeared to be a firearm and peeping into multiple windows at an apartment complex on Paseo Padre Pkwy. Upon responding, officers located the subject in the main courtyard and arrested him. The firearm in question was not a firearm but a lighter. #240416039

Robbery

On 4/17, officers responded to a robbery at a discount store at the Fremont Hub. A subject brandished a firearm at employees and demanded that they open the cash register. The subject then pistol-whipped an employee who was attempting to call 911. Unable to open the register, the subject placed the firearm in a backpack and fled on a small bicycle. Officers responded to contain and search the area, finding the subject's clothes nearby. This case remains under investigation. #240417039

On 4/18, a victim reported that a subject stole fishing lines from his truck outside a fast-food restaurant on the 3900 block of Washington Blvd. The victim confronted the subject, who pulled a fishing knife from the victim's truck and lunged at him. The subject fled on foot and was seen brandishing the same knife at others in the parking lot. Upon arrival, officers arrested the subject. #240418038

On 4/23, officers responded to a report of a robbery near Central Ave and Fremont Blvd. A victim had arranged to buy marijuana and was approached by two subjects. One subject entered his vehicle, and the other stood at his window. When the victim produced cash to pay for the marijuana, the subject at the window pointed a gun at him. The subjects took the cash and some of the victim's belongings and fled on foot into a residential complex nearby. This case remains under investigation. #240423003
