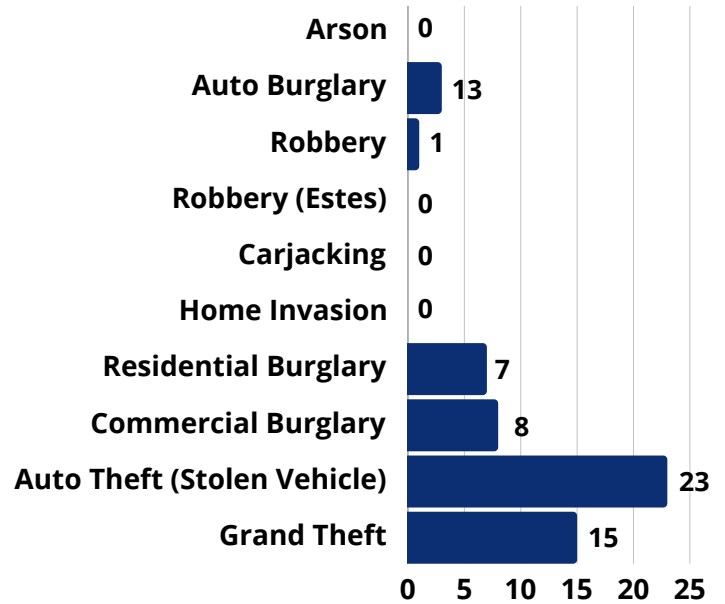




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/8, officers responded to an apartment complex on Medina Common regarding a subject arguing with his girlfriend (victim) in the apartment. The victim said the subject cut her with a kitchen knife. The subject fled on foot but eventually returned to the residence, where officers arrested him. #240508027

On 5/9, officers responded to a victim who reported that her husband was ramming his vehicle into hers as she was seated inside it on Stevenson Blvd. Officers located the subject and arrested him. #240509056

## Battery

On 5/13, officers responded to a report of battery at Fremont Blvd and Mowry Ave. A victim said an unknown subject walked up to him and struck him in the face. The subject threw his bicycle at the victim's windshield and broke it. Officers arrested the subject. #240513027

## Hit and Run

On 5/9, a subject ran a red light at Mission Blvd and I-680, striking the front end of another vehicle. The subject sped down Mission Blvd, cutting off other drivers, and the victim driver followed her. Eventually, the subject pulled into a parking space at a shopping center near Mission Blvd and Pine St. The victim driver used his vehicle to block the subject's vehicle inside the parking space and called police. Officers responded and arrested the subject. #240509033

## Injury Collision

On 5/11, officers responded to a collision in the parking lot of a gas station on Auto Mall Pkwy and Fremont Blvd. A vehicle had drifted into a light pole, and the driver and passenger inside were unconscious and not breathing. Fremont Fire Department administered naloxone to no effect. Officers supplied additional naloxone, and both the driver and passenger began to breathe again. They were transported for medical treatment. #240511008

## Injury Collision

On 5/11, officers responded to a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision on the 38600 block of Overacker Ave. It appears that the pedestrian intentionally ran toward the moving vehicle. He was transported to a hospital for care and sustained non-life-threatening injuries. He will be undergoing a mental health evaluation. #240511025

## Suspicious Circumstances

On 5/10, officers responded to a shipping center on Cushing Pkwy regarding three packages destined for an address in a nearby city. Security at the shipping center discovered more than \$54,000 in cash inside the packages. #240510013

On 5/11, officers responded to an apartment complex on Quantum Dr regarding a trail of blood on the elevator wall and floor. Officers discovered that the blood was from a dog that lives in the building, and a juvenile had accidentally allowed the elevator doors to close on the dog's tail. #240511034

## Vandalism

On 5/12, officers responded to a high school on Fremont Blvd regarding a subject who used a pipe to damage multiple windows at the school. The subject was also seen smashing the front window of a residence in the area. This case remains under investigation. #240512023 and #240512024

## Warrant Service

On 5/8, a passerby heard a woman screaming inside a panel van near a fast-food restaurant on Auto Mall Pkwy. Officers responded and discovered that the woman was arguing with a subject, who fled on foot before officers arrived. The subject had multiple outstanding arrest warrants. Officers located the subject barricaded in a nearby RV. At the request of the RV's owner, officers contacted the subject inside, removed him from the vehicle, and arrested him. #240508006
