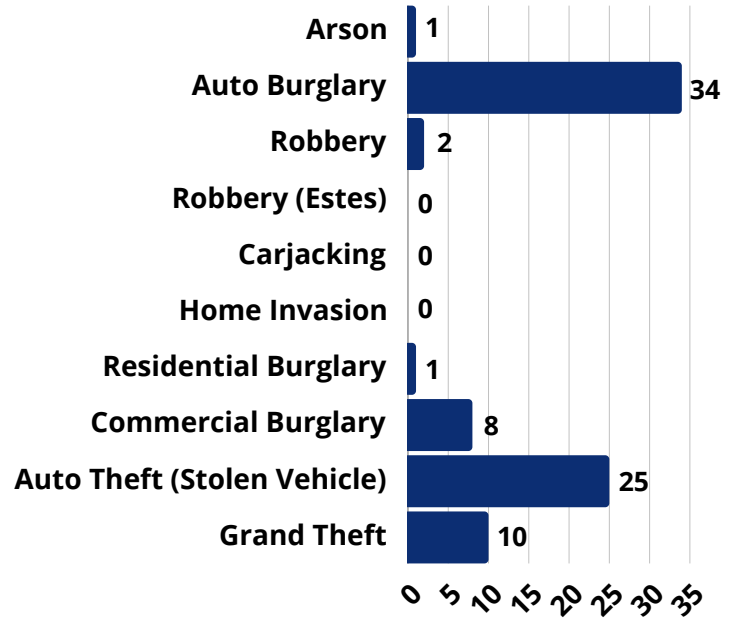

## Arson

On 5/21, security at a factory on the 45000 block of Fremont Blvd reported that a subject lit a car on fire in the parking lot. Security believed it was the same subject who had slashed the tires of multiple vehicles the previous week. Officers discovered that the subject had thrown a Molotov cocktail into an occupied vehicle. The victim was uninjured. The subject fled in a vehicle before officers arrived, but was arrested later that day. He said he was unaware that the vehicle was occupied. #240521001

## Auto Burglary

On 5/22, dispatch received a report that three subjects broke into a rental truck and stole firearms. Another auto burglary was reported with subjects and a vehicle matching the same description. In the second auto burglary, the reporting party said one of the subjects had pointed a weapon at a group of juveniles. Officers located the subject vehicle near Romilly Way and Gibraltar Drive, and the vehicle fled northbound on I-880. This case remains under investigation. #240522046

## Auto Theft

On 5/27, officers responded to an attempted vehicle theft near Carol Ave and Roberts Ave. The victim walked out to his vehicle and discovered a subject in the driver's seat, attempting to steal it. The victim pushed against the door to trap the subject inside, but the subject used a wrench to smash the window. He chased the victim while swinging the wrench at him, then fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #240527001

## Brandishing a Weapon

On 5/25, officers responded to a disturbance involving a subject who was lighting cardboard on fire and brandishing a knife toward onlookers. Officers contacted the subject and located drug paraphernalia on his person. The subject was arrested. #240525020

## Criminal Threats

On 5/21, an employee of a restaurant on Argonaut Way was in her vehicle in the parking lot when she was approached by a subject who began banging on her window. He began punching and kicking the air and circled her vehicle. He then told the employee that he was going to shoot her and that he had a firearm. As officers arrived, the subject fled toward a nearby apartment complex. Officers eventually detained and arrested him. #240521005

On 5/23, officers responded to a report of a subject threatening to rape a victim who was walking into her workplace on California St. The subject had been sleeping on the ground outside of the building, and it appeared he was masturbating under a blanket. Officers arrested the subject. #240523022

## Kidnapping

On 5/25, a subject battered his girlfriend (victim) and her family, then forced the victim and their infant child into a vehicle near Eugene St. The subject threatened to return to the house and shoot another family member, then fled in the vehicle. Later that day, the victim called dispatch and provided her location. The victim and infant were found alone in the vehicle and unharmed near Tavis Pl and Old Warm Springs Blvd. This case remains under investigation. #240525024

## Mental Health Hold

On 5/21, officers responded to a report from a mother (victim) who said her adult daughter (subject) had battered her. When officers arrived, the subject stepped out wielding a knife. Officers attempted de-escalation with the subject, but she refused to communicate. The subject eventually went to a neighbor's house and broke a window. She returned home and refused the officers' commands. Still armed with the knife, she approached officers. Officers arrested her and placed her on a mental health hold. #240521008
