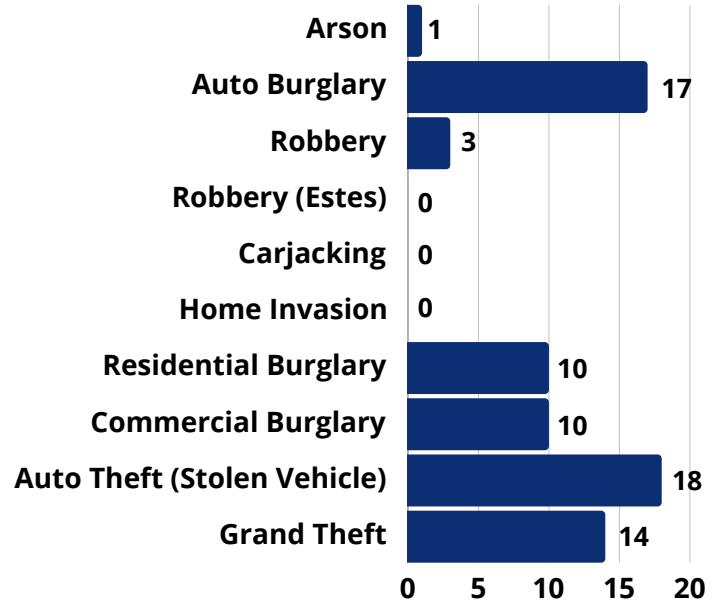

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 7/19, officers responded to a report of five subjects fighting at a liquor store on Fremont Blvd. Several subjects were drinking alcohol together and began brawling over a disagreement. One subject broke a beer bottle and used it to stab two other subjects, then fled before officers arrived. This case remains under investigation. #240719031

Domestic Violence

On 7/22, Dispatch received a call regarding a speeding minivan on Camellia Dr. A victim inside the minivan was screaming for help and attempting to open the sliding door. The victim said the driver (subject) had a knife and threatened to crash the vehicle and kill them both. Officers responded and saw the subject flee, jumping over a fence. Officers located the subject in the backyard of a residence and arrested him. #240722053

Grand Theft

On 7/18, a victim withdrew \$1,000 from his account at a bank on Mowry Ave and returned to his vehicle in the parking lot. A subject approached the victim, planted cash on the ground nearby, and said the victim had dropped the money. The victim helped the subject pick up the cash, but when he returned to his vehicle, the cash he had withdrawn was gone. The subject had left before the victim realized his money was missing. This case remains under investigation. #240718025

Unlawful Fire

On 7/19, officers responded to an outside assist request from Fremont Fire Department for a fire at Fremont Blvd and Beard Rd. The reporting party believed his house was going to burn down. FFD extinguished a small grass fire near a wall that backed up to homes on Fremont Blvd. FFD contacted a subject nearby who had some minor burns and said he was asleep nearby when the fire started. The subject provided a false name. This case remains under investigation. #240719011

Vandalism

On 7/16, officers responded to the area near a hospital on Sundale Dr after employees reported seeing a subject throwing rocks at a nearby building. The subject fled from officers and jumped the fence into an assisted living facility on Walnut Ave. The subject also matched the description of a report in which a subject had poured paint on one vehicle and scratched other vehicles. Officers located the subject and discovered controlled substances in his possession. He was arrested. 240716020 and #240716022

On 7/17, officers responded to a gift shop at the Fremont Hub regarding a subject who stole two statues from the store and smashed one on the ground. Another caller reported that the subject had thrown a rock at their window. Officers located the subject and arrested him. #240717050

Vehicle Code Violation

On 7/22, the Mobile Evaluation Team unit executed a planned relocation of a large encampment on Stewart Ave. The MET unit has been working with the homeless population, business owners, and City of Fremont staff since May to provide resources and options to those experiencing homelessness.
