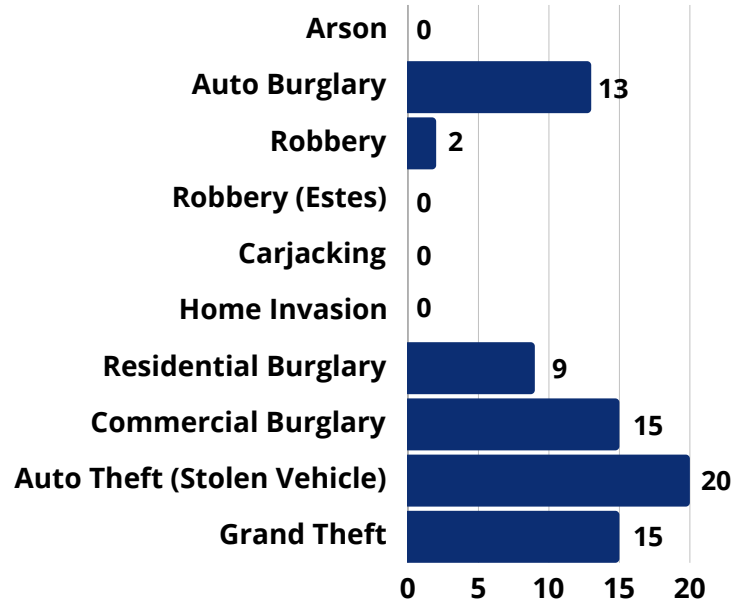

Auto Burglary/Auto Theft

On 8/16, officers responded to a report of an auto burglary at an apartment complex on Beethoven Common. The reporting party found three subjects inside her vehicle, and the windows were smashed. The subjects exited and fled over a wall. Shortly afterward, another victim reported that three subjects had stolen his vehicle on Lloyd Ave. These cases remain under investigation. #240816047 and #240816048

Battery

On 8/18, officers responded to a battery in front of a restaurant on Farwell Dr. The victim was about to enter the restaurant when the subject tapped her on the shoulder. The subject was wearing only a t-shirt. The subject forced the victim into a hug and tried to kiss her. The victim's family and several bystanders intervened, which caused the subject to flee. Officers identified the subject and authored a warrant for the subject's arrest. #240818029

Brandishing a Firearm

On 8/14, officers responded to a fast food restaurant on Auto Mall Pkwy regarding a subject who brandished a firearm. Officers located the subject and arrested him. #240814026

Criminal Threats

On 8/28, officers responded to the Paseo Padre Pkwy and Chadbourne Dr area regarding a subject who was swinging a large stick and yelling at people. The subject had used the stick to threaten multiple victims in the area. He was unable to formulate a coherent sentence for officers and was arrested. #240818010

DUI Collision

On 8/17, officers responded to a traffic collision at Paseo Padre Pkwy and Oakridge Dr. The collision is believed to have been caused by a subject who drove left of center and struck a vehicle head-on. Officers found controlled substances and a loaded automatic firearm with an extended magazine inside the subject's vehicle. The subject was arrested. #240817026

Hit and Run/Stolen Vehicle

On 8/17, officers responded to a hit-and-run collision near an apartment complex on Hansen Ave. A witness saw a vehicle crash into multiple parked vehicles and flee the scene. Officers learned the truck had been stolen earlier that day from the parking lot of a bar on Peralta Blvd. This case remains under investigation. #240817004 and #240817005

Robbery

On 8/18, officers responded to a report of a robbery near Cortez Ave. and Magellan Dr. The juvenile victim was riding his bicycle home from school when a subject on a bicycle blocked the sidewalk in front of him. The subject showed the handle of a firearm and demanded the victim's bicycle. The victim turned his bicycle over to the subject, who fled with it. This case remains under investigation. #240818028

Strong Arm Robbery

On 8/14, officers responded to a hit-and-run report. Investigation revealed that two cars had been involved in a road rage incident on I-880. The victim driver followed the subject to the Auto Mall Pkwy and Boyce Rd area, and both parties exited their vehicles to confront one another. The victim took out her cell phone to record the subject, and the subject grabbed the phone and fled with it. The victim's phone was later recovered in a nearby city, though it was damaged and no longer working. This case remains under investigation. #240814039

Suspicious Circumstance/Drug Possession

On 8/19, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at a commercial building on Mowry Ave. A subject was reported to have turned off the power switches, disrupting the building's electrical supply. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. He was also on probation for other crimes and was found with methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. #240819006
