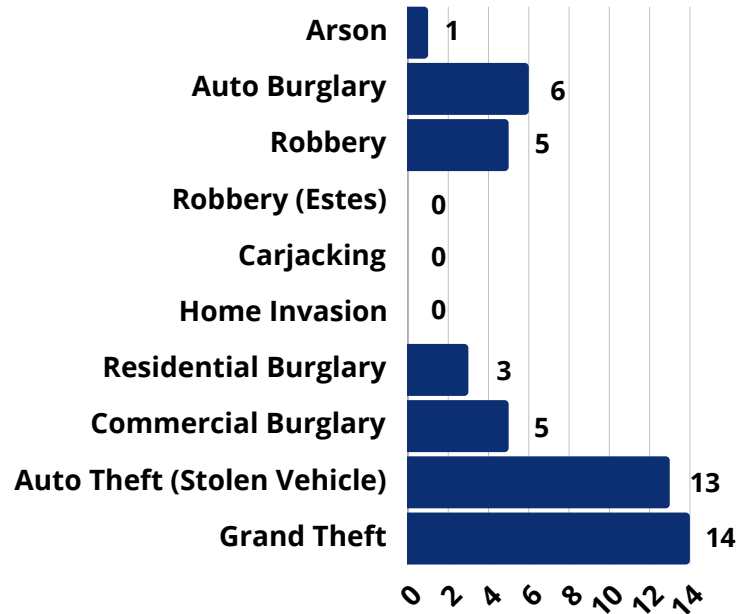




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 10/1, officers responded to reports of a subject with a knife at an apartment complex on Camden St. The subject had followed the victim home from a nearby convenience store. When the victim exited his vehicle, the subject attempted to stab him. The subject also threatened another victim with his knife. The subject fled in a vehicle but was located in a parking lot nearby. Officers arrested the subject and recovered a large knife from his vehicle. #241001001

## Brandishing a Weapon

On 10/4, a victim reported being chased near Lake Elizabeth by a subject swinging an elastic band with metal rings attached. The subject approached the victim and began following him, swinging the metal rings in the victim's direction. Officers arrived and arrested the subject. #241004017

## Domestic Violence

On 10/1, a victim reported that her boyfriend beat and threatened to kill her in an apartment on Medina Common. The victim and subject had been arguing about money earlier in the evening. The victim said she had been trying to get away from the subject, but he kept her phone from her. The victim took the phone back when the subject fell asleep and called the police. Upon responding, officers observed visible injuries on the victim's head and face. Officers arrested the subject. #241001002

## Robbery

On 10/5, officers responded to a convenience store on Mowry Ave and Farwell Drive regarding a robbery. A subject had stolen multiple items and threatened to kill the employee inside. The subject left the store before officers arrived, leaving the stolen items outside the store. Officers eventually located the subject in front of the store and arrested him. #241005049

## Shoplifting

On 10/4, officers responded to a report of a subject stealing items from a department store at the Fremont Hub. The subject stuffed items into luggage from the store and walked out of the store. The subject also possessed drug paraphernalia and burglary tools. Officers cited the subject. #241004026

## Suspicious Circumstance

On 10/4, dispatch received a call from a subject claiming to be in crisis. The subject said he was at a department store on Osgood Rd and said he was armed with a pistol and wanted to shoot people. Officers responded to the department store but could not find a vehicle that matched the subject's description of his vehicle. Officers contacted several subjects in the parking lot, but none matched the caller's name or description. The call was determined to be unfounded. #241004029

## Unlawful Fire

On 10/3, officers responded to the area of Greenwood Dr regarding a subject who lit a brush fire near a residence. The reporting party said the subject had used a lighter and rag to ignite some dried grass and shrubbery. Upon searching the area, officers located the subject, who had a gas lighter refill on his person. Officers arrested the subject. #241003023

## Vandalism

On 10/4, officers responded to a convenience store on Mowry Ave and Farwell Drive regarding a disturbance. A subject was banging on the front door and yelling. As officers responded, the subject threw an object at the front door and broke the glass. Officers detained the subject and arrested him. #241004002
