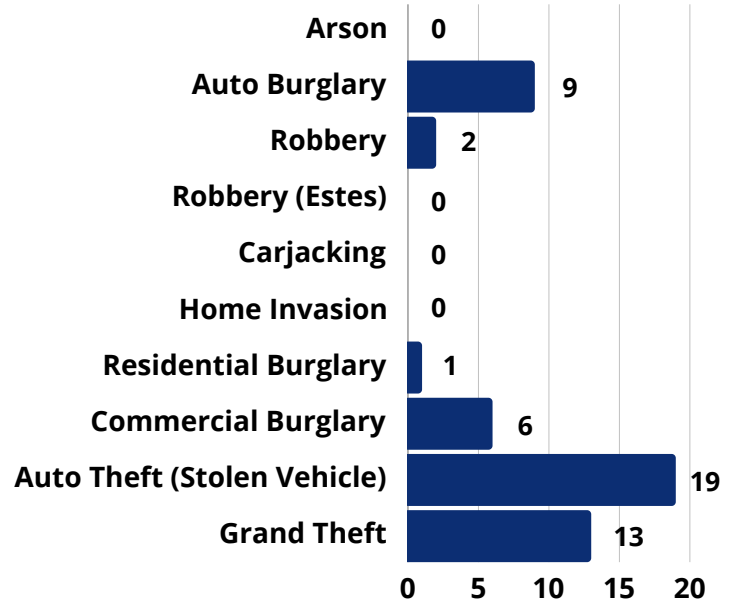

## Attempted Vehicle Theft

On 10/28, a victim reported that a subject had attempted to steal his vehicle in the parking lot of the train depot on Fremont Blvd. The subject had tried stealing the victim's vehicle but was unsuccessful, then attempted to steal another vehicle. The subject had shattered the vehicle's window and crawled inside it. Officers responded and located the subject on the train platform. He resisted initially, but officers eventually arrested him. #241028003

## Auto Burglary

On 10/23, officers responded to a hotel on Mowry Ave for multiple auto burglaries in progress. Hotel security observed subjects breaking into vehicles in the parking lot. The employee attempted to stop them and was physically assaulted. The subjects fled in a vehicle. #241023004 and #241023005

## Criminal Threats

On 10/28, a victim reported that her ex-boyfriend (subject) had been threatening to harm her. The subject showed himself in possession of a firearm and was waiting for the victim at her workplace. The subject had an extensive criminal history, including multiple weapons violations. Officers located the subject on foot near Innovation Way and Fremont Blvd. The subject was initially compliant, but as officers were searching him, he fled on foot. The subject eventually surrendered, and officers arrested him. A search of the subject's vehicle revealed a loaded handgun with an extended magazine. #241028002

## Drunk in Public

On 10/23, officers responded to a gas station at Grimmer Blvd and Auto Mall Pkwy regarding a subject who was striking vehicles with his hands. The reporting party advised that the subject had been in an altercation with others at the gas station. The subject fled on foot but was located nearby. Officers found him showing signs of being under the influence and arrested him. #241023021

## Misc Public Service

On 10/27, a reporting party advised seeing a subject on a bicycle in front of an elementary school on Warm Springs Blvd. The subject was seen putting a firearm in his pocket. Officers responded and contacted the subject, who was found to be a juvenile. The firearm in question was a pellet gun that the subject had found on the ground. The subject surrendered the pellet gun to officers and was released. #241027014

## Outside Assist

On 10/22, officers responded to assist with an incident regarding a 19-month-old juvenile who was not breathing. An FPD officer was first to arrive at the residence and conducted a sternum rub on the juvenile. The juvenile regained consciousness and began breathing again. Fremont Fire Department and Emergency Medical Services took over medical care. #P24125310

On 10/23, officers responded to an outside assistance request from the Fremont Fire Department at a residence on Finnigan Ter. The reporting party noticed a small brush fire behind the residence and could hear someone yelling. FFD responded and extinguished the fire. FFD noted that a subject was seen walking near the fire but did not find an accelerant that would indicate an intentional arson. The fire did not damage the residence or property. #241023001

On 10/28, security at a business on Page Ave reported that an employee arrived at work with a minor stab wound. Investigation revealed that the stabbing likely occurred in another city. The report was forwarded to the other city's police department, and the employee was transported for medical treatment. #241028005
