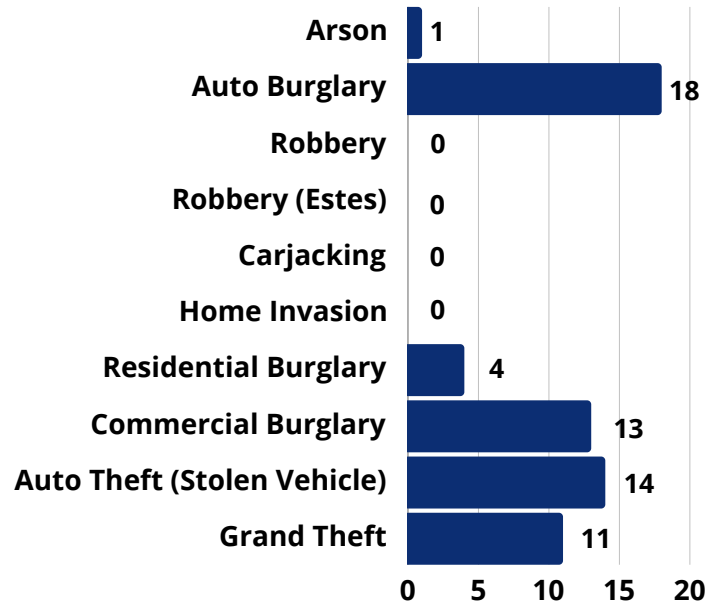

Arson

On 11/24, officers responded to a report of a subject who started a fire near a residential fence line near Sandpiper Pl. Upon noticing officers, the subject fled on foot, and officers could not locate him. However, one officer obtained a photo of the subject, and officers identified him. A warrant will be sought for his arrest. #241124004

Auto Burglary

On 11/24, officers responded to a report of a subject who entered a victim's vehicle on Glenmoor Dr and had been sleeping inside it. The victim contacted the subject, who threatened the victim with a knife. Officers established containment around the vehicle and began negotiating with the subject. Attempts to negotiate were unsuccessful, so officers opened the rear hatch of the vehicle and deployed a non-lethal device. After several seconds, the subject surrendered. #241124021

Domestic Violence

On 11/21, officers responded to a domestic disturbance at a residence on Blanchard St. The reporting party (subject) said her husband (victim) should not be at their residence because they are in the process of getting a divorce. Officers contacted both parties and learned that the victim had gone to the house to talk with the subject about the divorce. The subject then used a baseball bat to shatter the window of the victim's vehicle. She also used a hammer to hit the victim and break his phone. Officers arrested the subject. #241121005

Injury Collision

On 11/24, officers responded to a vehicle collision near Mission Blvd and Las Palmas Ave. A group was traveling in two vehicles; one had stalled just north of the intersection. The second vehicle parked behind the stalled vehicle, and two males began pushing it. A driver who was not associated with the group collided with the rear vehicle, pushing it into one of the males and severing his leg. Officers arrived and provided medical treatment, and the injured male was taken to a hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Shoplifting/Petty Theft

On 11/19, officers responded to a grocery store on Fremont Blvd regarding a shoplifting incident. A subject stole a large quantity of alcohol and threatened an employee as he ran out of the store. Officers located the subject nearby and found that he also had an outstanding warrant. The subject was arrested. #241119045

On 11/20, officers responded to a drugstore on Mowry Ave regarding a subject who was screaming and throwing items inside the store. The subject collected various items around the store and exited without paying for them. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested her. #241120009

Vandalism

On 11/19, officers responded to an incident of vandalism on Peralta Blvd. The subject was throwing items at juveniles and threw a rock through the window of a nearby business. The subject fled but was located behind another business. He resisted officers but was taken into custody by force. Officers arrested the subject. The next day, officers responded to a preschool on Maple St regarding a report that the subject was yelling at children on the playground. Officers arrested the subject again. #241119028 and #241119030

On 11/22, officers responded to a grocery store on Walnut Ave regarding a subject who was ramming a shopping cart into the store's doors and shattered them. The subject was initially combative, but officers restrained and arrested him. #241122009
