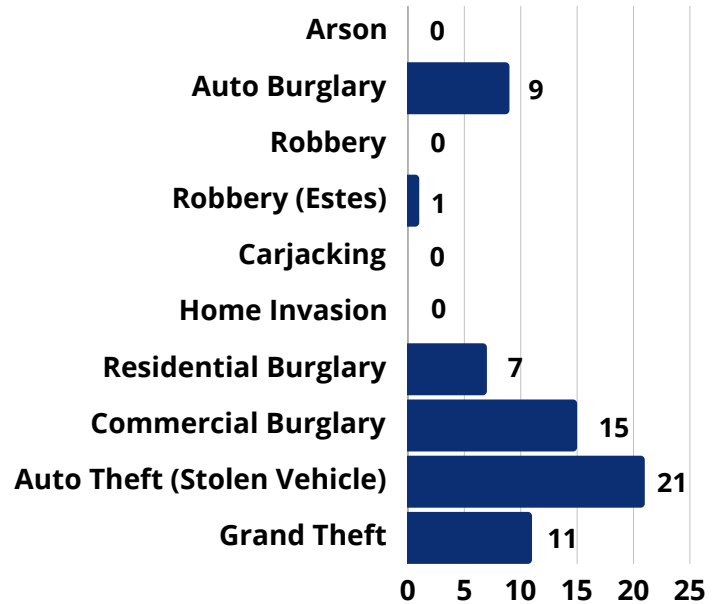

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 11/16, officers responded to an apartment on Schelbert Ter regarding a fight between a victim and his brother (subject) inside their shared apartment. During an argument over domestic issues, the subject tackled the victim to the ground and strangled him. The victim lost consciousness, and the subject grabbed a clothing iron and threatened to kill the victim. The altercation continued, with the subject using the iron, the iron's cord, a dining table chair, and a kitchen knife to attack or threaten the subject. Officers arrived, and the subject surrendered without incident. The victim sustained moderate injuries and was treated on scene, then transported for further care. #241116023

Child Abuse

On 11/15, officers responded to a residence on Adams Ave regarding a family battery. The subject and his juvenile son (victim) were involved in an argument that escalated into a physical altercation, during which the subject brandished a kitchen knife at the victim. The victim attempted to grab the knife from the subject and sustained a minor laceration. Officers arrested the subject and notified Child Protective Services. #241115001

Commercial Burglary

On 11/18, officers responded to a report of a commercial burglary at a supermarket on Warm Springs Blvd. Two subjects burglarized the store and fled on a dirt bike. An officer followed the dirt bike to a hotel on Landing Pkwy, where the two subjects dismounted and walked inside. Officers discovered the dirt bike had been stolen out of a nearby city. Inside the hotel, the two subjects had changed clothes and exited from the opposite side. Officers quickly located the two subjects in the area and arrested them. #241118003

DUI

On 11/12, officers responded to a residence on Pardee Ave regarding a subject who parked in front of the reporting party's home and urinated. When officers arrived, the subject was passed out in the driver's seat. When the subject awoke, he showed signs of being under the influence of alcohol, and officers arrested him. #241112040

DUI

On 11/15, officers responded to a vehicle collision at an apartment complex on Paseo Padre Pkwy. A subject had crashed into the complex gates and was inside the vehicle. Officers found the vehicle still in gear and the driver asleep at the wheel. The driver was also found to be intoxicated, and officers arrested her.

Vandalism

On 11/12, officers responded to a residence on Canopy Ter regarding a disturbance. A subject had removed the screen from one of the windows and was banging on the front door. The reporting party yelled at the subject, and the subject left on foot. Another reporting party at a residence on Lowry Rd reported that the subject had been banging on his door and damaging his property. Officers found the subject at a nearby residence and arrested him. #241112003
