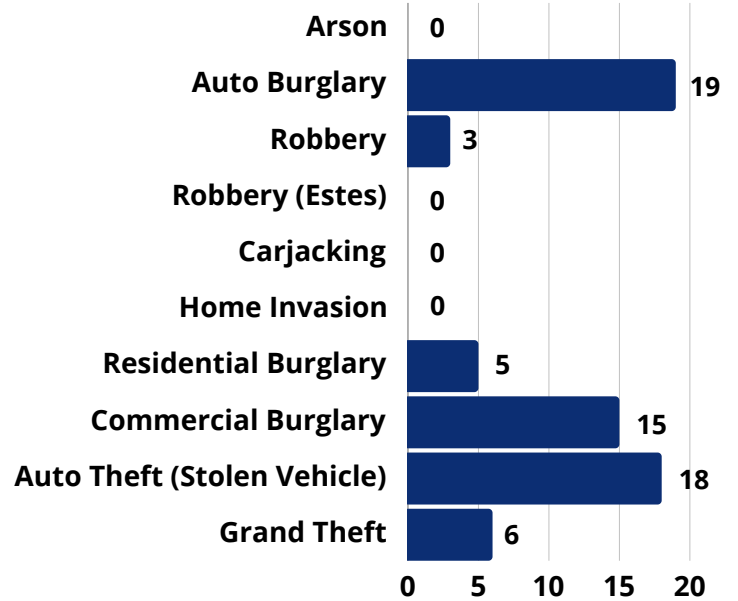




Fremont Police Week In Review

Found Child

On 12/1, officers responded to the intersection of Stevenson Blvd and Blacow Rd regarding a juvenile found in the roadway. The juvenile had been located by a passerby who saw her walking in and out of traffic. The juvenile was transported to the Fremont Police Department while officers awaited instructions from Child Protective Services. Approximately an hour later, the juvenile's mother contacted the police to report her missing, and the child was reunited safely with her mother. #241201006

Mental Health Hold

On 11/26, two reporting parties advised that they had seen a subject drop a baby in a stroller multiple times near a department store on Pacific Commons Blvd. The subject was also shaking the stroller with the baby inside. The subject got into a vehicle with the juvenile, and one reporting party followed the subject's vehicle, reporting that it was swerving as it traveled out of the city on I-880. Officers contacted the vehicle in a nearby city and found the subject was experiencing a manic episode. The juvenile was not belted into a car seat. Officers placed the subject on a mental health hold, and the juvenile was transported for medical evaluation. Child Protective Services took custody of the juvenile. #241126036

On 11/27, officers responded to a call regarding a shirtless subject who had climbed on top of a roof at a residence on Osgood Rd. The subject was screaming for help and pacing back and forth on the roof. Multiple officers responded and attempted to communicate with the subject, who responded incoherently and advised he had consumed a large quantity of alcohol earlier that day. Officers provided a ladder, and the subject came down. He was placed on a mental health hold. #241127027

Prowling

On 12/1, officers responded to a residence on Elmore Ct regarding a subject who kept knocking on the resident's door with a kitchen knife in his pocket. The subject repeatedly asked to speak with someone who was not associated with the residence. Approximately one week earlier, the same subject had come to the residence asking for the same person. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #241201014

Resisting Arrest

On 11/30, an employee at a bar on Fremont Blvd reported that a group of subjects were in a physical altercation inside the bar. Officers arrived and contacted a subject banging on a car window, attempting to fight with another subject. Officers restrained the subject and arrested her. #241130043

Robbery

On 11/26, security from a grocery store on Warm Springs Blvd called to report a subject who had stolen beer from the store. Upon being confronted, the subject punched the security guard and slapped the phone out of a witness's hand. Officers responded and found the subject drinking the beer in the parking lot. He resisted officers but was detained and arrested without further incident. #241126003

Stolen Vehicle

On 11/26, a reporting party advised that they could see a subject stealing a box truck near a storage facility on Albrae St. Officers saw a truck traveling south on Albrae St and initiated a traffic stop. The truck abruptly stopped, and the driver exited, fleeing on foot. Officers initiated pursuit, and the subject stopped and listened to commands. The owner of the vehicle later reported the vehicle stolen. Officers arrested the subject. #241126004

Terrorist Threats

On 11/28, a victim at a residence on Boone Dr reported that her son was threatening to kill everyone in the house. Officers located the subject walking away and arrested him. No weapons were located in the subject's possession. #241128010

Vandalism

On 11/28, officers responded to multiple reports of a subject damaging several vehicles in the parking lot of an apartment complex on Darwin Dr. The subject was arguing with himself and had thrown a rock at two vehicles. Officers arrived and arrested the subject, who showed signs of being under the influence of a narcotic. #241128001
