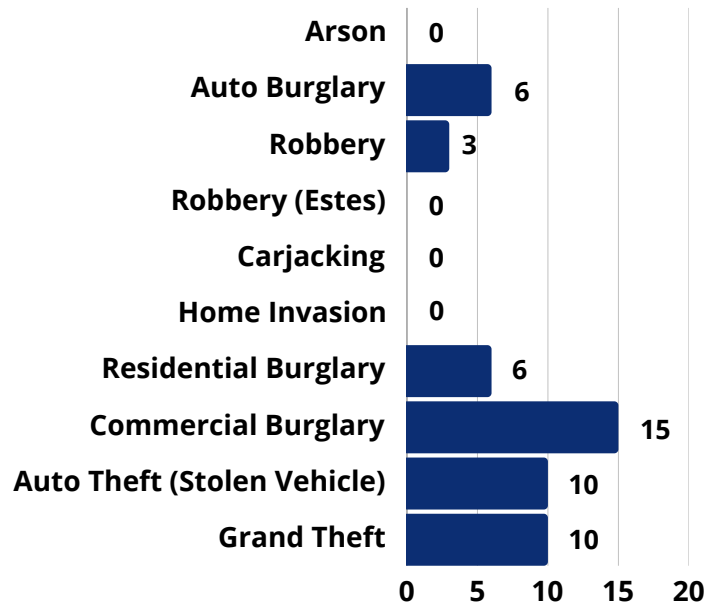




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Battery

On 1/15, officers responded to the area of Enea Ct and Gadwall Common regarding a battery. When officers arrived, the victim was lying on his back in the roadway. The victim said a juvenile subject was attempting to steal alcohol from a grocery store on Fremont Blvd and had fled the store. The victim chased the subject, confronted him, and the two began wrestling. The subject struck the victim several times and fled on foot, but officers located him nearby. The victim was transported for medical treatment, and the subject was cited and then released to a parent. #250115019

## Commercial Burglary

On 1/20, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd regarding a burglary. Two subjects used a sledgehammer to shatter the front glass doors and force open the safe. The subjects removed two drawers from the safe and fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #250120002

## DUI

On 1/16, an officer responded to a solo vehicle collision on Paseo Padre Pkwy. A vehicle was on the wrong side of the road and had crashed into a "no parking" sign. The driver displayed signs of intoxication, admitted to consuming alcohol before driving, and was placed under arrest. #250116045

## Robbery

On 1/14, a victim reported that she had been robbed on Carnation Way. The victim said the subjects stole her purse, injured her arm, and fled in a vehicle. The vehicle was also associated with a recent robbery in another city. FPD detectives located the vehicle in a nearby city and arrested three subjects. The vehicle was determined to be stolen, and a large amount of cash, including the original victim's loss, was recovered. #250114009 and #250114010

## Robbery

On 1/19, officers responded to a grocery store on Fremont Blvd regarding a robbery. A subject was attempting to steal items when an employee (victim) confronted him. The subject punched the victim in the face and yelled at other employees before fleeing on foot. Officers found the subject nearby and arrested him. #250119015

## Threat to Commit a Violent Crime

On 1/19, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Grimmer Blvd regarding an assault. Two juvenile subjects had ordered in the drive-thru and believed they had been given the wrong change. They entered the store and began yelling at the employees. One subject also pushed the manager and threatened to kill the employees. Officers arrived and detained both subjects. One subject was cited and released to a parent. #250119008

## Trespassing

On 1/13, officers responded to a hospital on Mowry Ave regarding a subject who refused to leave the premises after being discharged. Officers told the subject to leave multiple times, but she was uncooperative. Officers arrested the subject. #250113002

## Warrant Service

On 1/16, officers responded to a grocery store on Walnut Ave regarding a battery. The manager said a subject had attempted to steal items and had battered someone standing in front of another store. Officers located the subject nearby and found that he had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. Officers arrested the subject. #250116036

On 1/16, officers responded to a report of a vehicle on fire in the intersection at Industrial Dr and Fremont Blvd. The Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire, and officers discovered that the driver had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. Officers arrested the subject, then cited and released him. #250116009
