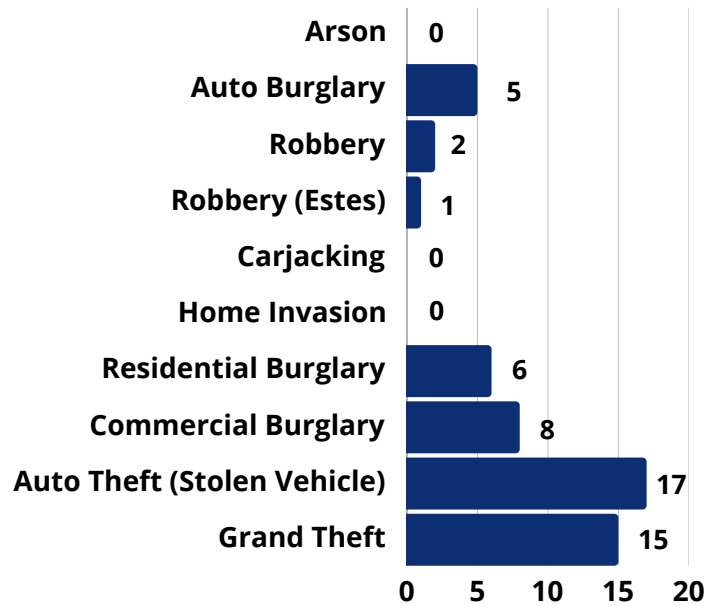

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 1/21, officers responded to a report of an assault with a deadly weapon at a department store on Fremont Blvd. A store employee (victim) saw a subject lying on the ground outside the store and went to check on him. When the subject was unresponsive, the victim offered to call for an ambulance or police. The subject jumped up and swung a pair of scissors at the victim multiple times. Officers arrived and arrested the subject. The victim was not injured. #250121010

On 1/22, an officer responded to a commercial property on Westinghouse Dr regarding an assault with a deadly weapon. An employee (victim) saw a subject attempting to steal pallets. When the victim attempted to stop the subject, he punched the victim's hand and fled in a truck, nearly running over the victim as he fled. #250122026

Found Firearm

On 1/24, an officer responded to a business on Lakeview Blvd regarding a firearm that was found in the water canal. An employee at the business was pumping water when the firearm clogged the pump. Officers discovered the firearm had been reported stolen in 2006 and booked it into Property and Evidence. #250124005

Grand Theft

On 1/21, an officer took a report from a business on Boscell Rd regarding a stolen cargo load. The business had sent several servers to a client in another state, but the cargo was stolen in transit. The approximate loss was \$528,000. #250121011

On 1/27, officers took a report of grand theft at a restaurant on Fremont Blvd. The victim withdrew \$15,000 in cash from a nearby bank, then drove to the restaurant to order food, leaving the cash inside the vehicle. While inside, he was alerted that his vehicle had been entered and found the door open. Upon leaving the restaurant, he discovered that his money had been stolen. #250127018

Mental Health Hold

On 1/21, officers responded to a report of a subject obstructing traffic near Irvington Ave and Grimmer Blvd. The subject was running in and out of traffic, attempting to get struck by a vehicle. Officers detained the subject and placed her on a mental health hold. She was transported for medical evaluation. #250121016

Residential Burglary

On 1/25, officers responded to a residential burglary on Thornton Ave. The residence had been ransacked, with food and clothing all over the floor. The sliding door was found open, and the screen door had been cut. The victim believed her ex-boyfriend (subject) was responsible for the burglary. Upon searching the residence, officers found him hiding in a bedroom. Officers arrested the subject, who also had two outstanding felony warrants. #250125022

Resisting a Police Officer

On 1/27, officers responded to a report of a subject at a hospital on Kearney St who was brandishing a knife and yelling at patients. When officers arrived, the subject walked away from them and refused commands to stop. Officers detained the subject and arrested him. #250127012

Robbery

On 1/26, officers investigated a jewelry swap robbery near Coralline Ct and Blackstone Way. The victim was standing on the sidewalk outside his residence when three subjects drove up and asked for directions. As the victim walked closer to give them directions, one subject exited the vehicle and attempted to put jewelry on the victim. The victim refused, but another subject came out of the vehicle, held onto his wrists, and removed his necklaces. The three subjects fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #250126015

Suspicious Circumstances

On 1/25, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd regarding an arson. The reporting party said they saw a subject setting a fire in a trash can. Officers arrived and extinguished the fire. The subject who started the fire was not located. #250125002
