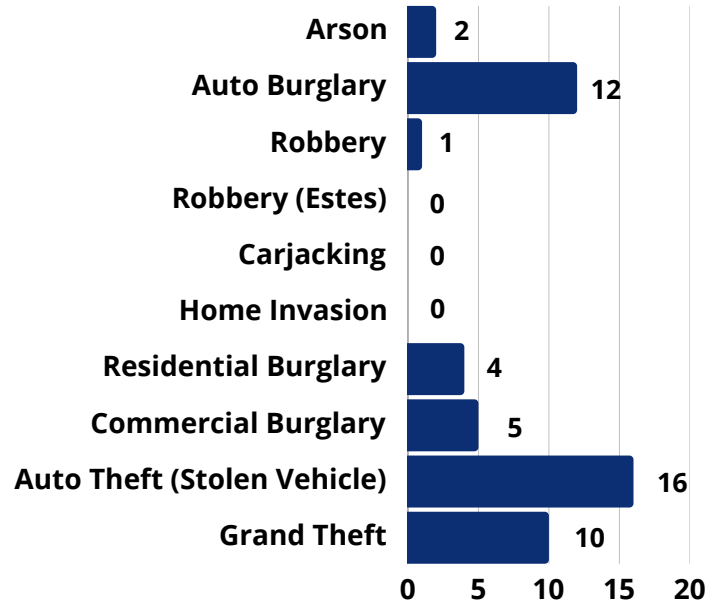

Arson

On 1/29, officers responded to a report of arson in a parking lot on Liberty St. A subject had set a patch of bushes on fire. By the time officers arrived, Fremont Fire Department had extinguished the fire. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. The subject said he had started a different fire in the same location the night before. #250129026

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 1/28, officers responded to a reported shooting in a parking lot on Mission Blvd. The subject saw the victim coming out of the bushes, and the two had a verbal dispute, which escalated when the subject pulled out a BB gun and shot the victim several times. The subject also shot the victim in the head and threatened to kill him. Both parties remained on scene as officers arrived. Officers arrested the subject. The victim had non-life-threatening injuries. #250128030

Brandishing a Weapon/Trespassing

On 1/29, officers responded to a report of trespassing at a building under construction on Sabercat Rd. The building's security guard (victim) located two subjects in the structure and asked them to leave. One subject pointed a handgun at the victim, who fled to his vehicle. Officers searched the property but did not find either of the subjects. #250129004

Mental Health Hold

On 1/30, officers responded to reports of a subject pointing what was believed to be a rifle at passing cars near Eggers Dr and Camden St. One reporting party saw the subject walk into a residence on Eggers Dr, and officers established a perimeter around the residence. A nearby high school was asked to initiate a shelter-in-place order. Officers successfully negotiated for the subject to exit the home, and then detained him outside. The item the subject was pointing at cars was actually a homemade sword with a laser on it. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250130011

Mental Health Hold

On 2/2, officers responded to a bank on Mowry Ave regarding a subject who was screaming and had destroyed the bank's front glass doors. The subject fled on foot with a shopping cart, and officers located him nearby, with glass from the bank doors in his cart. He made several incoherent statements, and officers placed him on a mental health hold. #250202024

Parole Violation

On 2/1, officers responded to an apartment on Fremont Blvd regarding a suspicious person. A victim reported that a subject had followed her to her apartment and was waiting outside after knocking several times. Officers arrived and found the subject to be exposing himself. The subject was also on active parole and provided false identification to officers. He was arrested. #250201021

Residential Burglary

On 1/30, officers responded to an in-progress residential burglary on Tamayo St. The victim was at home with her juvenile son when a subject knocked at the front door. The victim did not answer, and shortly afterward, the subject went to the back patio and attempted to break in. Officers responded, located the subject nearby, and arrested him. #250130008

Robbery/Kidnapping

On 1/28, officers responded to a call from a nearby agency regarding a robbery/kidnapping. A victim had sold a vehicle to a subject who believed the vehicle was defective. The subject responded to the victim's residence, battered him, and threatened to kill him. The subject forced the victim to go to a bank on Mission Blvd and withdraw money, and then both parties went to a mechanic shop in another city. The shop was closed, so the victim and subject separated, and the victim flagged down an officer from another agency. FPD officers arrived and arrested the subject. #250128017

Unlawful Fire

On 1/28, officers responded to a report of a subject lighting a pile of trash on fire in the parking lot of a restaurant on Stevenson Blvd. The reporting party saw large flames near the side of a building. Officers responded with Fremont Fire Department and saw the subject fleeing on foot. Officers apprehended the subject and arrested him. Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire. #250128005
