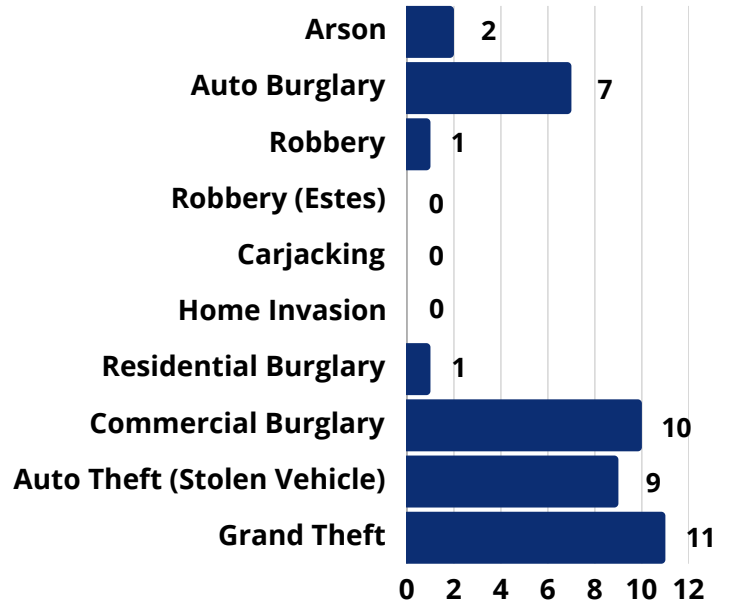

Arson

On 2/7, officers responded to an arson on Purpleleaf St. A subject was standing in the middle of the road for approximately 45 minutes before opening a suitcase and lighting it on fire. The subject was also waving a large knife. The subject walked away before officers arrived, but was located nearby and detained. Officers placed the subject on a mental health hold. Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire. #250207003

On 2/9, officers responded to a convenience store on Fremont Blvd to investigate a possible arson. A subject used a cigarette to light a fire in a trash can next to the occupied building. He fanned the flames to engulf it further, then walked away. A witness extinguished the fire before officers arrived. There was smoke damage to the property, but no occupants were injured. Officers found the subject nearby and arrested him.

Battery

On 2/7, officers responded to the intersection of Boscell Rd and Bunche Rd regarding a battery. A pedestrian (subject) crossed the street against the signal, walking in front of a driver (victim). The two had a brief verbal dispute before the subject walked up to the victim's window and punched him. Officers arrested the subject.

Commercial Burglary

On 2/7, officers responded to a construction site near S Grimmer Blvd and Wisdom Rd regarding a subject attempting to force the gate open. The subject went inside and was collecting construction materials and tools. When officers arrived, the subject fled on foot. Officers cleared the building but did not find the subject. #250207001

On 2/4, officers responded to a vehicle collision on Peralta Blvd and Paseo Padre Pkwy. Three vehicles were involved and one crashed through a fence and into a building. One party was transported for medical care.

Mental Health Hold

On 2/6, officers responded to a residence on Buchanan Pl regarding a report that a juvenile subject was drunk and threatening suicide by cop. Officers removed family members from the residence, but the subject followed them outside. He resisted officers but was detained without further incident. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250206003

On 2/7, officers responded to multiple reports that a subject was running into traffic on Bay St. and Grimmer Blvd. Officers responded to the incident multiple times and ultimately placed the subject on a mental health hold. #250207014

Robbery

On 2/9, officers responded to a café on Warm Springs Blvd regarding a robbery. A subject spat on the floor and stole tips from the tip jar. Approximately an hour later, the subject returned to take more money, then screamed and spat on an employee who tried to move the tip jar away from him. He also threw the café's outdoor chairs at the windows before leaving. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #250209026

Shoplifting

On 2/7, officers responded to a report of shoplifting at a department store on Christy St. An employee saw two subjects removing anti-theft devices and placing products in luggage. Officers assisted with surveilling the exterior of the store and created an apprehension plan. When the subjects left the store without paying for the items, officers apprehended them in the parking lot and arrested them. #250207021

On 2/9, loss prevention personnel at a department store on Pacific Commons Blvd reported that a subject was hiding wine bottles in his shopping cart and bag. When the subject saw loss prevention personnel waiting outside the store, he ran outside, but officers were waiting nearby and arrested him. The subject also had multiple outstanding misdemeanor warrants. #250209022
