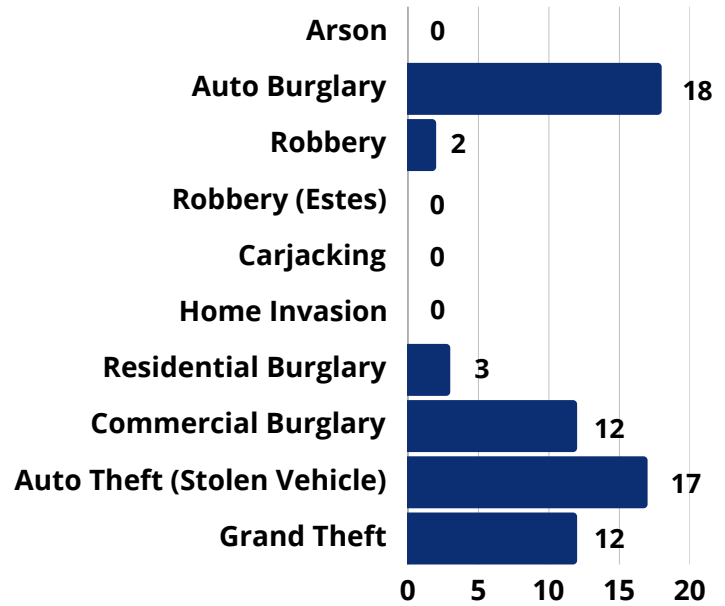

Commercial Burglary

On 2/18, officers responded to a burglary at a hotel on Mission Blvd. A witness saw two subjects entering the hotel from the second-story window. Officers searched the building and found the two subjects inside. The subjects believed the building was abandoned and had also stolen a serving dish. Officers arrested the subjects. #250218015

On 2/23, officers responded to a burglary at a smoke shop on Thornton Ave. Four subjects used a vehicle to smash through the front doors, then fled in another vehicle into another city. Robbery/Grand Theft from Person

On 2/18, an elderly victim was walking near Upland Way and Moray St when two subjects approached. They removed the victim's gold necklace and replaced it with costume jewelry. Shortly afterward, an elderly victim was walking on Buck Ct when two subjects offered her similar jewelry. When the victim refused, they forcibly removed her ring and fled in a vehicle. The subjects and the vehicle they fled in matched the description of the subjects in the first incident. #250218012 and #250218014

On 2/18, a reporting party advised that his grandfather (victim) had been robbed on Bay St. The victim and his wife were walking home when four subjects pulled up next to them in a vehicle. The subjects forcibly removed the victim's jewelry, then placed a fake gold necklace on him and put cash in his pocket. The subjects fled in a vehicle. #250218027

On 2/18, a victim was walking on Holly St when two subjects in a vehicle approached her. The victim spoke with one subject through the open vehicle window, and the subject insisted on hugging her. The subject also offered her jewelry and cash, which the victim declined. The subjects drove away, and when the victim returned home, she realized her necklace was missing. #250218030

Threat to Commit a Violent Crime

On 2/24, a victim reported that a subject threatened him with a firearm. The victim was cleaning the property and blowing debris, which upset the subject. The subject retrieved what was believed to be a firearm from his vehicle and then threatened to kill the victim. Officers located the subject in the bathroom of a nearby store and arrested him. The item that the subject used to threaten the victim was actually a BB gun, which officers found in a nearby bush. #250224007

Trespassing

On 2/24, officers responded to a preschool on Fremont Blvd regarding a subject who was shouting and drinking alcohol in front of the school. The subject was highly intoxicated and was transported for medical care. A trespass notice was issued. #250224013
