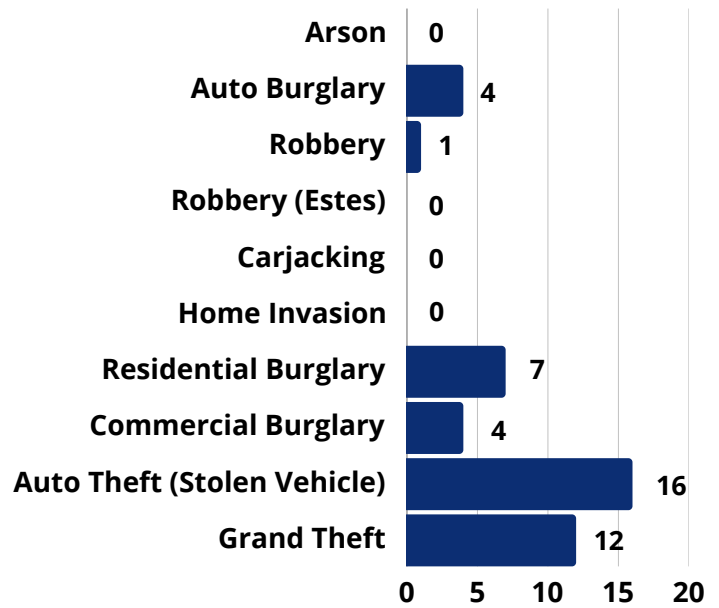




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 3/5, officers responded to a drugstore on Mowry Ave regarding a subject causing a disturbance. Store security confronted the subject after she continuously dug through garbage at the store entrance. The subject threatened to stab the guard and swung a pipe at him. Officers contacted the subject and arrested her. #250305003

On 3/6, officers responded to a shipping store on Mowry Ave regarding a subject loitering near the entrance and yelling at customers. He yelled at an employee (victim) who was outside on her break, then swung a box cutter at her, cutting her face. The subject fled before officers arrived, and the victim was transported for medical treatment. On 3/10, the victim saw the subject near Capitol Ave and Mount Vernon Ave and notified FPD. Officers responded and arrested the subject. #250306014

## Battery

On 3/4, officers responded to a fast-food restaurant on Mission Blvd regarding a battery. Two juvenile victims were inside the restaurant when a subject made multiple vulgar statements to them. The victim's mother entered the store and told the subject not to speak to her sons. The subject pushed her and got into a physical altercation with the two juveniles. He punched one juvenile and threw a sign at him. Employees locked the subject out of the store. Officers located him nearby and arrested him. #250304037

## Vehicle Collision

On 3/8, officers responded to a traffic collision on Mission View Dr. A vehicle collided with a residence and severed a primary gas valve. The vehicle's occupants were located nearby, uninjured. Officers evacuated adjacent residences, and the Fremont Fire Department responded to secure the gas line. #250308001

## Vehicle Collision

On 3/10, a driver collided with a light pole while leaving a gas station on Ardenwood Blvd. The driver sustained visible injuries, and the light pole was sheared. The driver was transported for medical treatment and a repair company responded to fix the light pole. #250310023

## Possession of a Controlled Substance

On 3/6, a reporting party was in her residence on Foxtail Ter when an unknown subject walked into her home via the front door. When confronted, the subject apologized and left. The subject did not take anything or touch the reporting party. Officers located the subject nearby and found he possessed a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. The subject was arrested. #250306015

## Residential Burglary

On 3/7, officers responded to a residence on Bass Lake St regarding a residential burglary. A subject was seen rummaging through the interior of the home. Officers responded and cleared the residence. No subjects were located inside the home. #250307019

On 3/7, officers responded to a residence on Logan Dr regarding a residential burglary. Three subjects were seen on surveillance cameras ransacking the home. The subjects fled on foot before officers arrived. Officers cleared the house, finding that the rear sliding glass door had been shattered. #250307020

## Trespassing

On 3/6, officers responded to a church on Temple Way after a reporting party advised that they saw someone inside and believed they were sleeping in the building. Officers contacted three subjects inside the building, including one with an outstanding felony warrant. Officers arrested all three subjects. #250306013

## Warrant Arrest

On 3/9, officers responded to a drugstore on Mission Blvd regarding a possible robbery. A subject was in a physical altercation with two customers and then stole beer. When officers contacted the subject nearby, he was intoxicated and yelling at passersby. He also had multiple outstanding warrants. Officers arrested the subject. #250309013
