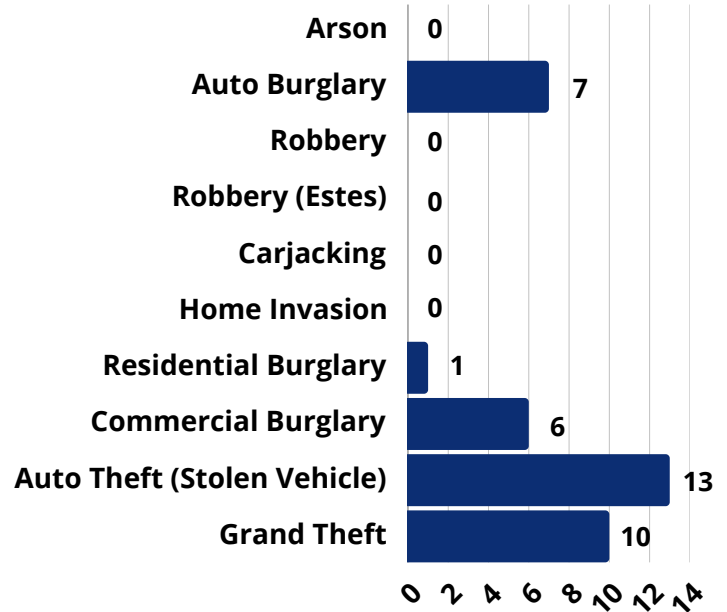

Battery

On 3/17, a victim was walking near Peralta Blvd and Fremont Blvd when an unknown subject punched him in the face. The victim held the subject until officers arrived. Officers arrested the subject, who kicked and spat on officers during the arrest. #250317019

Commercial Burglary

On 3/12, officers responded to a café on Fremont Blvd regarding a commercial burglary. The front door was shattered, and an alarm was sounding. Officers cleared the building, finding it empty. Surveillance footage showed two subjects throwing a hammer through the front door and stealing the cash drawer. Officers located the empty cash drawer nearby. #250312002

Grand Theft

On 3/11, a victim was sitting at the bus stop near Paseo Padre Pkwy and Country Dr when two subjects in a vehicle approached. The subjects offered to donate to the victim, then removed her necklaces before driving away. 250311016

On 3/16, a victim was walking on Paseo Padre Pkwy when three subjects in a vehicle approached. The subjects engaged the victim in conversation and one subject offered to pray for her. After the subjects drove away, the victim realized her necklace was missing. #250316009

Organized Retail Theft

On 3/11, officers responded to a report of petty theft from a department store on Boscell Rd. Loss prevention personnel from the store reported that a subject stole approximately \$900 worth of merchandise from the store. Officers located the subject at a bus stop in front of the store and detained him. Loss prevention recognized the subject from approximately 12 different prior theft incidents that had occurred at the store, amounting to a loss of more than \$5,000. Officers cited and released the subject. #250311015

Stolen Vehicle

On 3/11, a vehicle was stolen that contained more than \$360,000 worth of electronic equipment. Later that day, officers recovered the vehicle but found it no longer contained the electrical equipment. #250311005

On 3/16, officers responded to recover a stolen vehicle in the parking lot of an apartment complex on Paseo Padre Pkwy. As a tow for the vehicle was being arranged, a subject exited one of the apartments and drove away in the vehicle. Officers identified the subject, finding him to have an active felony warrant. #250316002

On 3/16, officers responded to a vehicle collision on Nicolet Dr. A subject vehicle collided with a parked vehicle, causing smoke to come out of the engine. Multiple witnesses reported seeing three juvenile subjects flee the subject vehicle on foot. Officers found that the steering column of the subject vehicle had been stripped and the vehicle had been recently stolen. Officers conducted an extensive search but did not find the subjects. #250316001

Suspicious Circumstance

On 3/12, officers responded to an apartment complex on Country Dr to assist Fremont Fire with a gas leak coming from a vehicle. There was damage to the vehicle's gas tank, but no fire damage to the vehicle. #250312001

Trespassing

On 3/14, officers responded to a report of a disturbance at a hospital on Mowry Ave. A subject claimed the hospital did not provide adequate service and was hiding in the bathroom, refusing to leave. Officers arrested the subject. #250314001
