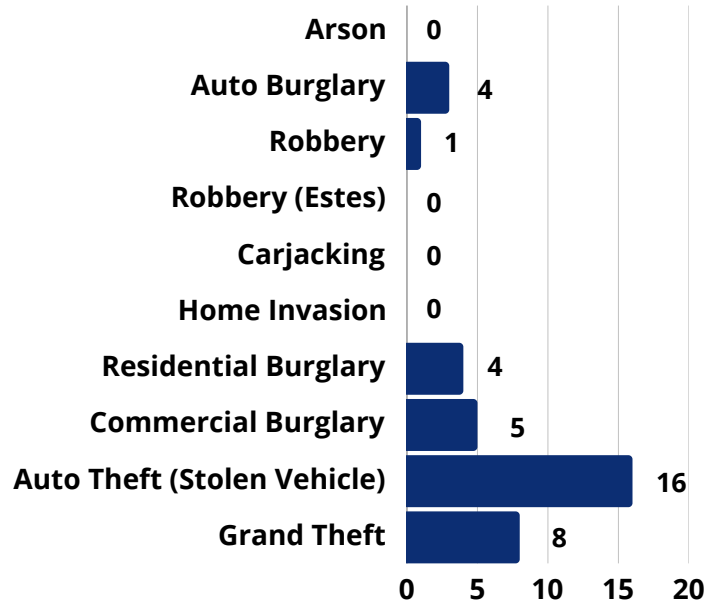

Auto Burglary/Stolen Vehicle

On 3/18, officers responded to an auto burglary at a residence on Colet Ter. The homeowner heard the car alarm go off and interrupted three subjects who had shattered the vehicle's window. When confronted, the subjects fled on foot, leaving behind the vehicle they arrived in. The vehicle had been stolen from an apartment complex on Heritage Common the previous week. Officers canvassed the area but did not find the subjects. #250313012 and #250318002

Criminal Threats

On 3/22, officers responded to a disturbance at a warehouse on Wolcott Dr and Union St. A former employee (subject) was breaking glass bottles and threatening the business owner (victim) and the owner's family. The subject also had multiple outstanding warrants. Officers arrested the subject. #250322022

On 3/19, officers responded to a collision at a fast-food restaurant on Fremont Blvd. Two vehicles collided, and one party was injured. A subject subsequently walked away from the crash. Officers located the subject, determined he was under the influence, and arrested him. #250319034

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 3/20, officers responded to a department store on Osgood Rd regarding a report of assault. A customer said a subject had slapped him. Officers contacted the subject nearby and found him with drug paraphernalia. The subject was arrested. #250320022

Residential Burglary

On 3/18, officers responded to an in-progress residential burglary on Washington Blvd. A contractor arrived at the residence and found a subject who had forcefully entered the vacant residence. Officers searched the residence but did not locate any suspects inside. #250318016

On 3/19, a victim parked in her garage on Hansen Ave when she noticed a subject had followed her home and was walking up her driveway. He interfered with the closing garage door, removed the victim's purse from her vehicle, and fled. #250319031

Robbery

On 3/20, officers responded to a robbery at a residence on Cheswycke Ter. The victim's ex-boyfriend (subject) snatched her necklace and fled in a vehicle. Officers located the subject on 3/23 and arrested him. #250320027

Theft

On the evening of 3/18, officers responded to a truck rental business on Thornton Ave regarding an in-progress theft. Employees said a subject was siphoning gasoline from one of the pumps. The subject fled before officers arrived, but officers located him hours later at a gas station on Mowry Ave. Officers found the subject with methamphetamine in his possession and arrested him. #250318027
