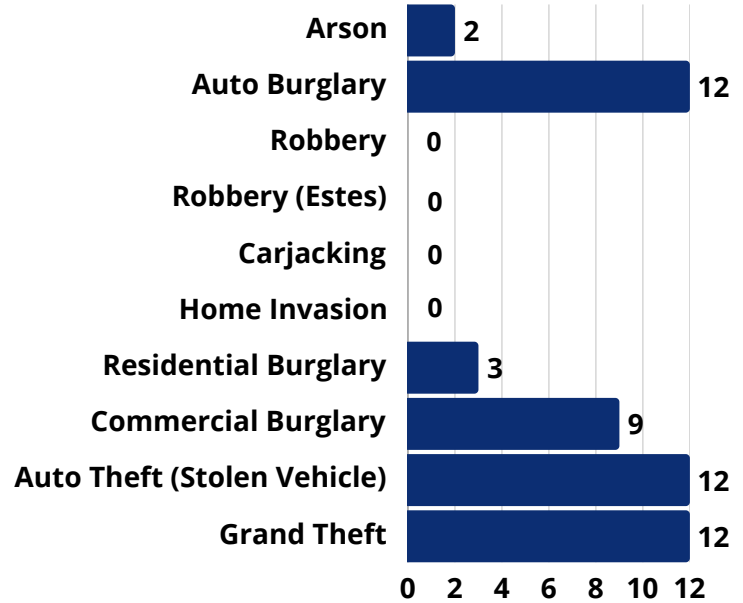




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Animal Cruelty

On 3/27, officers responded to an animal cruelty incident near Ratto Pl. A witness reported that a subject was beating a dog with a belt. Officers located the subject and dog the next day in a nearby residence. They took possession of the dog for safekeeping and evaluation. The case is being forwarded for charging. #250328012

## Domestic Violence

On 3/31, officers responded to an apartment on Mowry Ave regarding a domestic battery. The victim said he and his girlfriend (subject) were arguing when the subject cut him with a knife. When officers arrived, the victim had a cut wound and showed a video of the subject throwing the knife at him. Officers arrested the subject. #250331001

On 3/27, officers observed a suspicious person (subject) near a middle school on Fremont Blvd. The subject was looking into car windows and stole a bicycle from an apartment patio. ## Embezzlement

On 3/27, officers responded to an embezzlement at a grocery store on Stevenson Blvd. A manager (subject) had stolen more than \$16,500 from the store by conducting fraudulent returns and taking the cash or putting it on her personal cards. Officers contacted the subject at the store and placed her under arrest. #250327015

## Grand Theft

On 3/27, approximately \$20,000 of copper/fiber wiring was cut and removed from the aerial poles near Boyce Rd and Stevenson Blvd. A supervisor for the telecommunications company said a similar incident happened weeks earlier in another part of the city. #250327005

## Kidnapping

On 3/25, officers responded to a report of domestic assault at a residence on Red Hawk Circle. The victim said she and her ex-boyfriend (subject) had a physical altercation, during which he threatened her with a knife and held her hostage. She also believed he had a firearm. Officers responded to the residence with a K9, recovering an unserialized firearm. Officers arrested the subject. #250325011

## Residential Burglary

On 3/30, officers responded to a late-reported residential burglary on Irvington Ave. The victim returned home to find his rear window open, and a subject was inside his apartment. The subject said the house belonged to her relative, and she intended to sleep there. The victim explained that it was his house, and the subject fled. #250330019

## Vandalism

On 3/26, officers responded to a disturbance at a restaurant on Fremont Blvd. A subject was throwing rocks at vehicles and used a metal pipe to hit windows on nearby stores and vehicles. A restaurant owner reported that the previous day, the subject clogged the restaurant's toilet so severely that all the other drains in the restaurant had clogged. Officers located the subject, who was incoherent. She was transported for psychological clearance. #250326019
