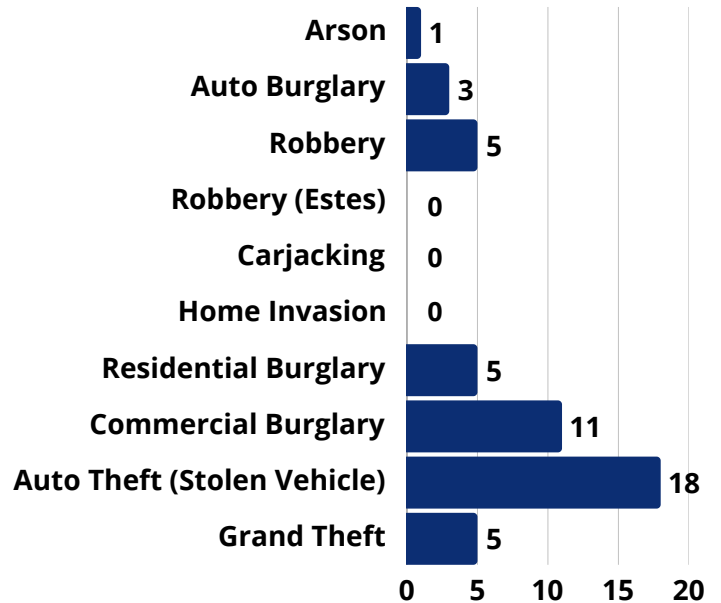

Arson

On 4/20, a reporting party at a residence on Mayten Way advised that his roommate (subject) had lit their garage on fire. The residents evacuated, and the Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire without incident. The subject fled on foot but was located nearby with a butane torch. The subject was placed under arrest. #250420004

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 4/20, officers responded to an assault near Fremont Blvd and Sundale Dr. The victim was sleeping on the porch of a commercial building when the subject approached him. The subject was verbally hostile and yelled at the victim, then used the victim's baseball bat to strike him multiple times. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #250420005

Embezzlement

On 4/16, officers investigated a report of embezzlement at a shipping warehouse on the 41400 block of Boyce Rd. Two employees (subjects) were stealing shipments of merchandise by removing the contents and shipping the empty packages to another location. The subjects had stolen more than \$7,000 worth of merchandise. The subjects were placed under arrest. #250416022

Mental Health Hold

On 4/21, officers responded to a residence on Mello Way regarding a subject threatening to kill his girlfriend and her family. The subject was armed with a knife and also threatened to commit suicide by cop. The subject advanced toward officers, refusing their commands. Officers deployed less lethal projectiles, and the subject dropped the knife. He was placed on a mental health hold. #250421006 and #250421007

Robbery

On 4/20, officers responded to a report of a robbery at a convenience store on Mohave Dr. Six subjects punched the clerk (victim), threatened him with a firearm, and pistol-whipped him. The subjects stole merchandise and cash, then fled in a vehicle before officers arrived. #250420003

Suspicious Fire

On 4/19, multiple callers reported a vehicle explosion and fire near Milton Ter. Fremont Fire Department responded with FPD officers, and several homes were evacuated as a precaution. FFD extinguished the fire, which had spread to two other vehicles. The three vehicles were unoccupied, and there were no injuries from the fire. #250419026

Trespassing

On 4/17, officers responded to a report of trespassing at a residence on Clough Ave. A subject had entered the victim's backyard, jumped on top of his garbage bins, and was on top of the victim's roof. When officers arrived, the subject was no longer on the roof. The investigation revealed that the subject had been driving a stolen vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest. #250417002

Vandalism

On 4/17, a subject rammed the gate into FPD's secure parking lot near Stevenson Blvd and Civic Center Dr, rendering the gate inoperable. Officers responded and detained the subject, who appeared disoriented and admitted to using several drugs before driving. The subject was placed under arrest. #250417004

On 4/18, officers responded to a disturbance at a convenience store on the 4000 block of Mowry Ave. A subject was yelling incoherently and demanding money from the cashier. When the cashier called for police, the subject pushed over displays and other items on the counter, damaging the register. The total damage caused was estimated at approximately \$20,000. The subject fled on a scooter, but officers located him nearby and arrested him. #250418027
