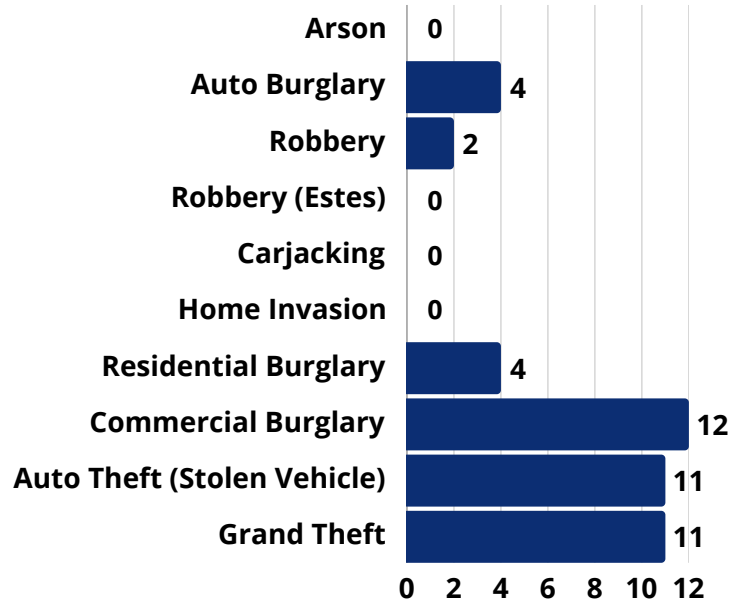

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 5/10, a husband (subject) and wife (victim) were involved in a physical altercation in their residence on Comstock Common. The subject threatened to kill the victim, then demanded she take their children and leave. The subject pushed the victim and hit her with a metal office chair. The subject was placed under arrest. #250510017

On 5/11, a victim reported that a subject struck him in the face with an object on the 34600 block of Fremont Blvd. Officers responded and placed the subject under arrest. #250511015

On 5/12, officers responded to a grocery store parking lot on the 46800 block of Mission Blvd regarding a fight between a victim and subject. The two were involved in a verbal altercation, after which the subject used a stick to stab the victim's face. The subject fled before officers arrived. The victim sustained minor facial injuries. #250512029

Mental Health Hold

On 5/10, a subject reported that she shot her mother and husband in their residence on Trenouth St. The subject threatened to commit suicide by cop. Officers responded and found the subject standing on the front porch with a firearm on the ground nearby. After officers verbally negotiated with the subject, she surrendered and was safely detained. All family members were contacted inside, unharmed. Two firearms were seized from the residence, and the subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250510014

Outside Assist

On 5/8, officers responded to a vehicle fire near Niles Canyon Road. The unoccupied vehicle was engulfed in flames. The vehicle was determined to have been stolen from another city. The Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire. No suspects were located. #250508001

Robbery

On 5/13, multiple reporting parties advised that employees were fighting with a subject at a department store on the 43700 block of Christy St. The subject had removed several items of merchandise and was wearing them as he walked out of the store. Loss prevention employees (victims) confronted the subject, who was pushing against the victims in an attempt to flee.. The victims detained the subject until officers responded, and the subject was placed under arrest. #250510016

Stolen Vehicle

On 5/12, officers observed a suspicious box truck parked on Northport Loop. The license plate did not match the vehicle, and it had been reported stolen out of another city. The ignition of the vehicle was damaged. Officers observed one subject accessing the vehicle and another subject inside the back. Both subjects were placed under arrest. #250512024

Trespassing

On 5/9, a victim reported that a subject had urinated in a restaurant on the 4100 block of Bay St. Officers contacted the subject in the parking lot and issued a trespass warning notice. #250509009

On 5/12, a victim reported that a subject was standing in the victim's backyard with a hatchet. The subject was using the hatchet to open boxes in the backyard. The subject had also broken the window screen and entered the residence through the window. Officers responded and placed the subject under arrest. #250512007

Vandalism

On 5/9, a victim reported that his vehicle had been vandalized outside his residence on Orangewood Drive. A subject picked up a metal scooter from the victim's yard and placed it on top of the vehicle, damaging it. Officers located the subject nearby and arrested him. #250509013
