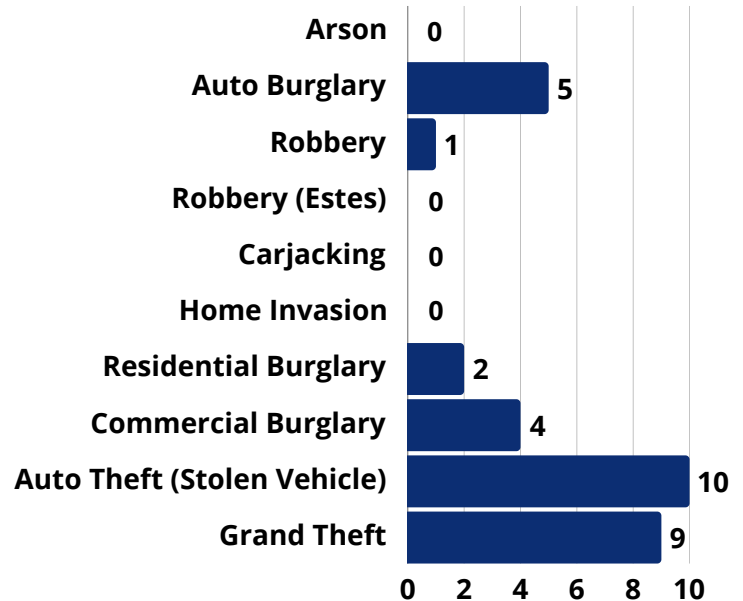




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Battery

On 5/26, officers responded to a report of family battery on Chadbourne Dr. The victim's ex-boyfriend (subject) drove to her workplace, battered her, and threatened to kill her. When the victim attempted to call the police, the subject broke her phone. When officers arrived and contacted the victim, the subject returned to the area. Officers obtained an emergency protective order for the victim. The subject was placed under arrest. #250526013

On 5/24, officers responded to a domestic disturbance at an apartment on the 47600 block of Mardis St. The reporting party (subject) and her ex-boyfriend (victim) were drinking and were involved in an argument. The subject struck the victim several times with a bottle opener. The subject was placed under arrest. #250524005

## Criminal Threats

On 5/25, several callers reported a disturbance at a thrift store on the 41200 block of Blacow Rd. A subject was yelling and attempting to touch young juveniles. He announced that he was going to kidnap a child. The subject threatened to strike a victim with a baseball bat, then fled on foot toward a nearby high school. The subject was also out of compliance with sex offender registration requirements. Officers located the subject and placed him under arrest. #250525010

## DUI Collision

On 5/23, officers responded to a solo vehicle collision on Warm Springs Blvd. A vehicle crashed into a restaurant, causing substantial damage. The driver (subject) fled before officers arrived but was located nearby and found intoxicated. The subject was placed under arrest. #250523002

## Grand Theft

On 5/20, officers responded to an in-progress theft at a department store on the 39200 block of Fremont Blvd. A subject ripped a phone from the display and walked out of the store. Officers saw the subject running and apprehended him after a short foot pursuit. The subject was placed under arrest. #250520020

On 5/25, officers responded to a report of battery between roommates at an apartment on the 4100 block of Stevenson Blvd. A subject and her roommate (victim) were in a verbal altercation, and the subject called 911 before leaving the residence. Officers responded and made contact with the victim, then left the scene. After approximately an hour, the victim called 911 to report that the subject had stolen his firearm. Officers contacted the subject via phone and responded to her location to take the firearm and return it to the victim. The subject was placed under arrest. #250525009

## Resisting Arrest

On 5/25, officers responded to an apartment on Router Common and Wisdom Rd regarding a suspicious subject. The subject was pulling plants from the ground in the complex and carrying multiple packages. When officers confronted the subject, he responded aggressively and fled on foot. Officers apprehended the subject and found that the packages he was carrying were stolen from nearby residences. The subject was placed under arrest. #250525012

## Theft

On 5/23, officers responded to a theft at a department store on the 39200 block of Fremont Blvd. Loss prevention personnel located a subject concealing items in a backpack. The subject fled on foot through the emergency exit doors. Officers located the subject near Fremont Blvd and placed him under arrest. The subject also had active warrants for theft. Loss prevention personnel recovered the stolen merchandise, which was approximately \$600 worth of items. #250523021

## Trespassing

On 5/26, officers responded to a report of trespassing at a storage facility on the 4500 block of Peralta Blvd. A subject had been living in one of the storage units for the last two weeks. The subject was a former facility customer and was evicted from one unit, then moved into an unlocked unit. The subject was placed under arrest. #250526008
