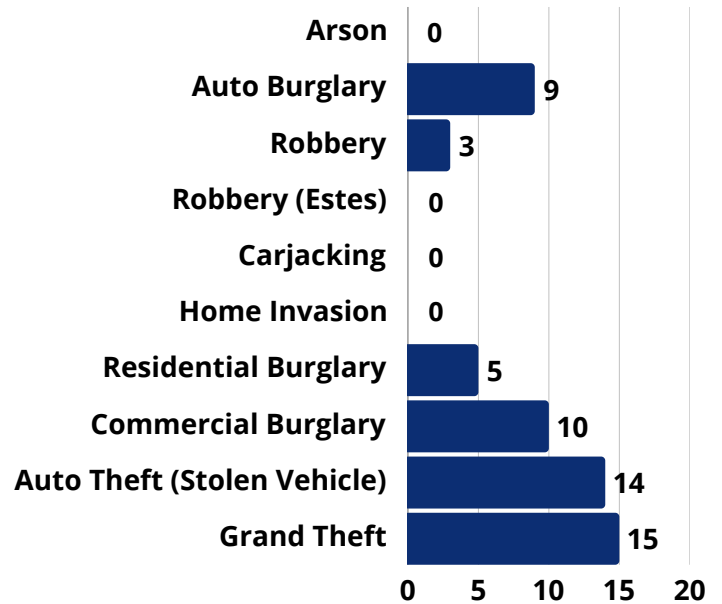




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Battery

On 6/2, officers responded to the area of Fremont Blvd and Auto Mall Pkwy regarding a battery between multiple subjects. Officers found one victim on the ground with injuries. The victim was walking in the area when several subjects attacked him. The subjects fled in a vehicle, which officers located near Grimmer Blvd and Blacow Rd with one adult subject and six juvenile subjects inside. The adult and four of the juveniles were involved in the battery. The five subjects were placed under arrest. The victim was transported for medical treatment. #250602003

## DUI

On 5/27, officers responded to a report of an intoxicated subject at a mobile home park on the 4300 block of Auto Mall Parkway. The subject was acting belligerently and refusing to leave. He had also rammed his vehicle through a locked gate. When officers arrived, the subject was severely impaired, and officers placed him under arrest. #250527023

## Fraud

On 5/28, an officer investigated a report of fraud at a manufacturing business on the 47900 block of Fremont Blvd. A subject emailed the business, posing as one of the business's vendors. The subject asked the business to change the bank account information on file for the vendor. When the business paid the vendor using the updated account information, the funds were routed to the subject's account. The total loss was approximately \$180,000. #250528026

## Residential Burglary

On 5/30, officers responded to a residential burglary on Anderson Ave. When the victim called police, the subject was still inside the home. Officers surrounded the residence and contacted the subject, who was initially noncompliant. Officers placed the subject under arrest, locating burglary tools. The subject also possessed illicit drugs and drug paraphernalia. #250530007

## Robbery

On 5/28, officers responded to a robbery at a gas station on the 4100 block of Mowry Ave involving six to seven subjects. The subjects drove a vehicle into the front of the store while an employee was working inside. The subjects loaded the store's ATM into a separate, waiting vehicle and fled in both before officers arrived. #250528006

On 5/29, a victim reported that he had been robbed by a motorcyclist (subject) while driving on Niles Canyon Rd. The subject motioned for the victim to pull over, and the victim complied. Another subject emerged from the shrubbery and used a firearm to smash the victim's car window. The subjects stole a briefcase containing approximately \$60,000 in cash that the victim was transporting for his employer. The subjects fled on the motorcycle. #250529027

## Stolen Vehicle

On 5/28, an officer located a stolen vehicle driving near Kimbro St and Eggers Dr. Upon seeing the officer's patrol car, the juvenile driver fled in the stolen vehicle. The vehicle was located unoccupied nearby, and the subject was seen running through a nearby elementary school. The subject was found at a nearby park, attempting to blend in with children on the play structure. The subject was detained and released to his parents. 250528014

## Tampering with a Fire Alarm

On 5/27, officers responded to assist Fremont Fire Department at a hotel on the 5400 block of Mowry Ave. FFD advised that a subject was acting erratically and had pulled the fire alarm multiple times. The subject had also damaged a hotel room by pulling the mirror off the wall. When officers arrived, the subject fled in a vehicle. She continued to flee at a low rate of speed, ignoring officers' emergency lights and siren. Eventually, the subject parked and exited the vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest. #250527024

## Vandalism

On 5/31, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a residence on Morley Pl. A subject was using a long tool to hit multiple vehicles that belonged to his brothers, destroying their rear windshields. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. #250531002
