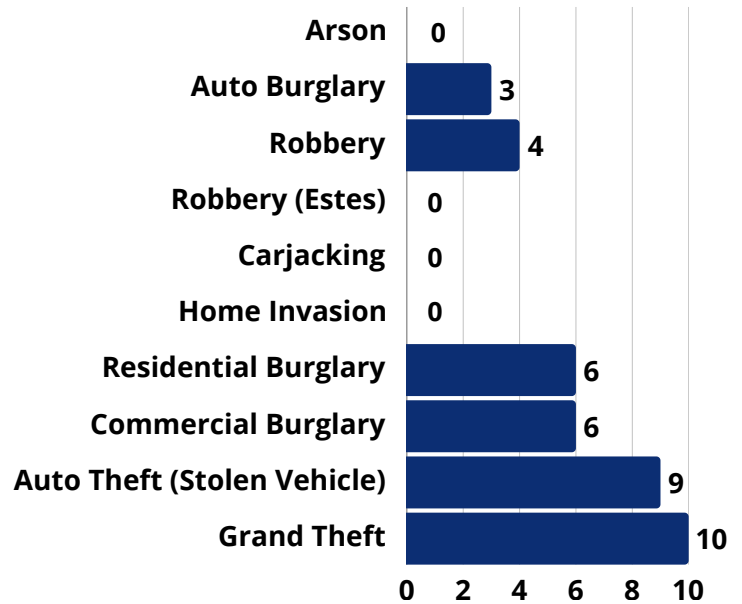

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 6/12, officers responded to a parking lot on Page Ave regarding a subject attempting to hit other vehicles with his own vehicle. The subject pursued a private security vehicle, attempting to rear-end it at high speeds. The subject also repeatedly rammed an occupied parked vehicle, then drove away. Later that day, another law enforcement agency located the subject in their jurisdiction and detained him. The subject was placed under arrest. #250612003

On 6/15, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at a residence on Penn Lane. The victim reported that her ex-boyfriend (subject) entered her bedroom, assaulted her, then stabbed her with a pocketknife. The subject continued to beat the victim until she lost consciousness. The victim regained consciousness and was transported for medical treatment. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. #250615027

Brandishing a Weapon

On 6/16, officers responded to a disturbance at a restaurant on the 39100 block of Paseo Padre Parkway. A subject swung a pole at employees, attempted to hit others with a cart, and was noncompliant with officers. The subject fled on foot but was apprehended and placed under arrest. #250616027

DUI

On 6/11, officers located a driver (subject) unresponsive in his vehicle on Walnut Ave. The vehicle was running, blocking traffic flow, and not displaying hazard lights. Officers attempted to wake the subject several times, but he remained unresponsive. Eventually, officers breached the windows, and the subject slowly responded. He showed signs of intoxication and was placed under arrest. #250611001

DUI

On 6/11, several parties reported that a driver (subject) was swerving into oncoming traffic and had nearly collided with other vehicles. Officers located the vehicle in a parking lot on Stevenson Blvd. The subject showed signs of intoxication and was placed under arrest. #250611032

Residential Burglary

On 6/13, officers responded to a residential burglary at an apartment on Bay St. A subject vaulted over a patio balcony, attempting to enter the apartment through the window. A resident fought with the subject in an attempt to detain him. Officers responded and placed the subject under arrest. #250613003

Robbery

On 6/10, a victim reported an attempted robbery in a parking lot on the 35600 block of Fremont Blvd. The victim was meeting a subject to sell a luxury watch. During the sale, the subject grabbed the watch out of the victim's hand and tried to flee on foot. The victim grabbed the subject, and a bystander helped pry the watch out of the subject's hands. The subject fled on foot. #250610023

Theft of Services

On 6/15, a subject broke into the water meter at a residence on Phelan Ave. On two separate occasions, the subject stole a total of approximately 3,700 gallons of water. #250615011

Vandalism

On 6/11, officers responded to a disturbance at a fast-food restaurant on the 38800 block of Fremont Blvd. A subject was screaming outside the restaurant, threw food, took an employee's phone, and broke the drive-thru window. The subject was placed under arrest. #250611002

Warrant Service

On 6/11, a reporting party noticed a suspicious vehicle parked in the driveway of her residence on Adams Ave. The subject inside was speaking incoherently and had pulled his pants down, leaving himself exposed. The subject also had an outstanding warrant. Officers placed the subject under arrest. #241020004
