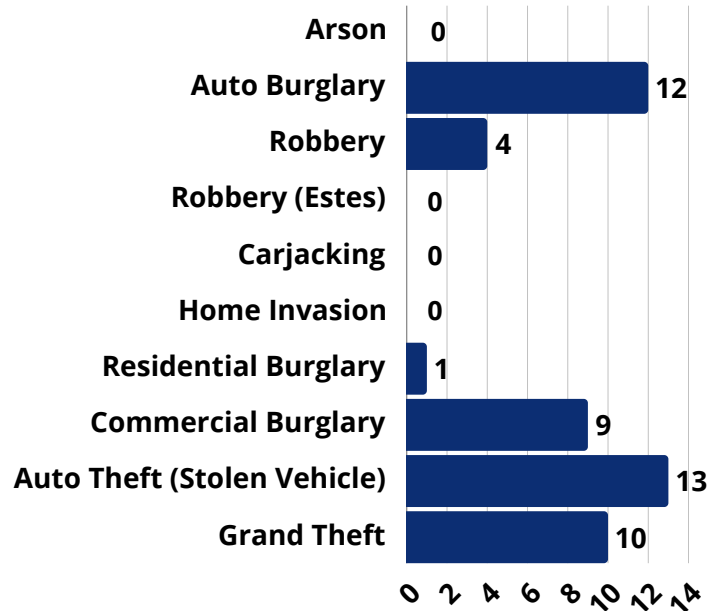




Fremont Police Week In Review

Auto Burglary

On 6/23, officers responded to an in-progress auto burglary on Calypso Terrace. A victim saw a subject opening the door, then entering her vehicle. The victim's husband chased the subject away. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. Grand Theft

On 6/21, officers responded to a report of theft at a tire store on the 3000 block of Beacon Ave. A victim withdrew \$15,000 in cash from a nearby bank and put it into a backpack in his vehicle. He took the vehicle to be serviced at the tire store, but when he returned to pick up his vehicle, the backpack was gone. #250621015

Robbery

On 6/17, an employee (victim) reported a robbery at a department store on the 44000 block of Osgood Rd. The victim was working the cash register when the subject brandished a firearm and demanded money. The subject took more than \$1500 in cash and fled with another subject on foot. The same subjects had also committed a robbery in another city and were arrested by another law enforcement agency. #250617021

On 6/18, officers responded to a robbery at a jewelry store on Mowry Ave and Farwell Ave. Multiple subjects used a vehicle to ram the front entrance of the business, forced entry, and proceeded to smash display cases before fleeing the scene in multiple vehicles. Officers located one of the vehicles involved. Four subjects were taken into custody, and stolen property was recovered from the vehicle. #250618016

Robbery

On 6/21, an officer responded to a robbery near Mowry Ave and Glenview Dr. An elderly victim was walking with her spouse when multiple subjects approached them. The subjects hugged the victim and put costume jewelry on her wrists. When the victim attempted to run away, the subjects chased her and forcibly removed her real jewelry. The subjects fled to their vehicle and drove away. #250621010

Selling Counterfeit Marks

On 6/20, an officer investigated a report of theft by false pretenses. A subject sold the victim a pair of counterfeit earbuds, claiming they were genuine. The subject was identified and contacted at his residence. Additional counterfeit merchandise was seized. The case will be forwarded for charging. #250620011

Shots Fired

On 6/23, officers responded to a shooting outside a bar on the 5000 block of Mowry Ave. The reporting party said a subject fired two rounds into the ground before leaving in a vehicle. While searching the area, officers found two expended casings and two bullet impacts in the dirt next to the sidewalk. There were no injuries caused by the shooting. #250623005

Spousal Abuse

On 6/22, officers responded to a group of people screaming near Leslie St and Stevenson Blvd. When officers arrived, the group had left in a vehicle, but officers located a victim at the scene. The victim said she and her husband (subject) were arguing inside a vehicle. When the victim exited the vehicle, the subject drove behind her, striking her in the foot with the vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest. #250622005

Warrant Service

On 6/23, officers responded to a disturbance on the 45000 block of Northport Loop. A subject was working on a truck and scattered its automotive components across the roadway. Officers contacted the subject and found he had an outstanding warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #250623017
