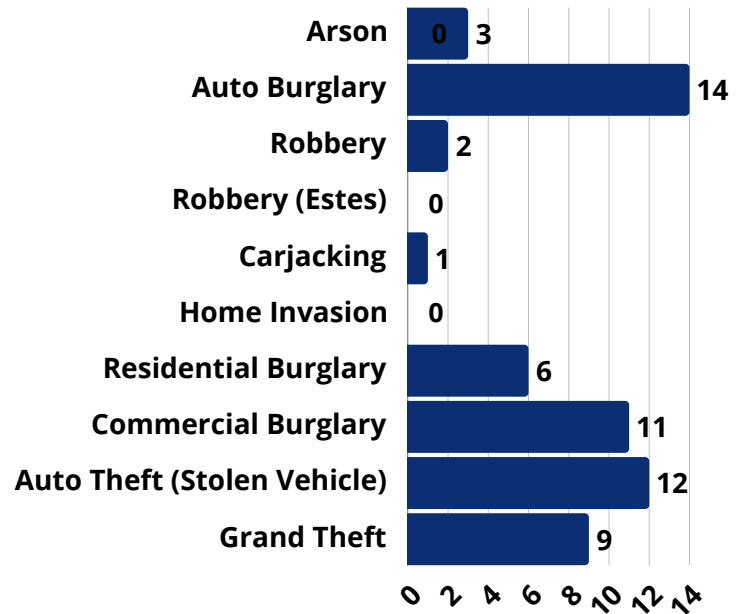

Arson

On 7/14, officers responded to a brush fire near Lowry Rd and Falcon Dr. The reporting party said a subject may have set the fire intentionally, and a second fire was located nearby in another city. Officers located the subject and placed him under arrest. #250714019

Attempted Carjacking

On 7/13, a victim at a residence on Iron House Ln saw three subjects attempting to steal his vehicle. The victim went outside to confront the subjects, and two of them brandished firearms at him. The victim retreated inside his residence, and the subjects fled before officers arrived. The subjects were unsuccessful in stealing the vehicle. #250713004

Battery

On 7/13, officers responded to a battery at a church on the 42000 block of Albrae St. The reporting party, along with other church members, had escorted a former member of the church (subject) off the property. While officers were enroute, the subject attempted to re-enter the church and placed the reporting party in a chokehold. Other parties actively separated them. Officers arrived, and the subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250713029 and #250713031

Domestic Battery

On 7/9, detectives were in the area of Fremont Blvd and Enea Common when they witnessed an altercation between a male subject and female victim on the side of the road. The two were later determined to be husband and wife. Detectives saw the subject shove the victim to the ground and attempt to move the victim into his vehicle against her will. Detectives intervened and restrained the subject. The subject was placed under arrest. #250709032

DUI Collision

On 7/10, officers responded to the area of Hillview Dr regarding a collision. A vehicle had crashed into a fence and collided with several parked vehicles. Officers contacted the driver (subject), who was found to be under the influence. The subject was placed under arrest. #250710037 and #250710038

Mental Health Hold

On 7/14, the manager of a gas station on Fremont Blvd reported that a driver (subject) was driving erratically near the pumps. Minutes later, the same subject came to the Fremont Police Department front parking lot and repeatedly honked his horn. Officers responded and contacted the subject. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250714011

On 7/14, officers responded to a disturbance at Fremont Blvd and Mowry Ave. A subject was running through traffic, throwing items into the street, and hitting himself. When officers arrived and detained the subject, he began yelling and threatening others. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250714014

Residential Burglary

On 7/11, officers responded to a residential burglary at an apartment on the 40000 block of High St. The reporting party saw a subject enter her residence from an unlocked window. Upon seeing the reporting party, the subject fled out of the front door. #250711004

Robbery

On 7/11, officers responded to a robbery near a fast-food restaurant on the 4300 block of Thornton Ave. The victim had parked at a nearby gas station and was walking away from his vehicle when a subject began walking quickly toward him. The subject attempted to pull the victim's satchel away from him. When the victim resisted, the subject beat him. The subject eventually left without taking the victim's satchel and fled in a vehicle. The victim had withdrawn several thousand dollars in cash from a bank prior to the robbery. The subject may have followed the victim from the bank. #250711023
