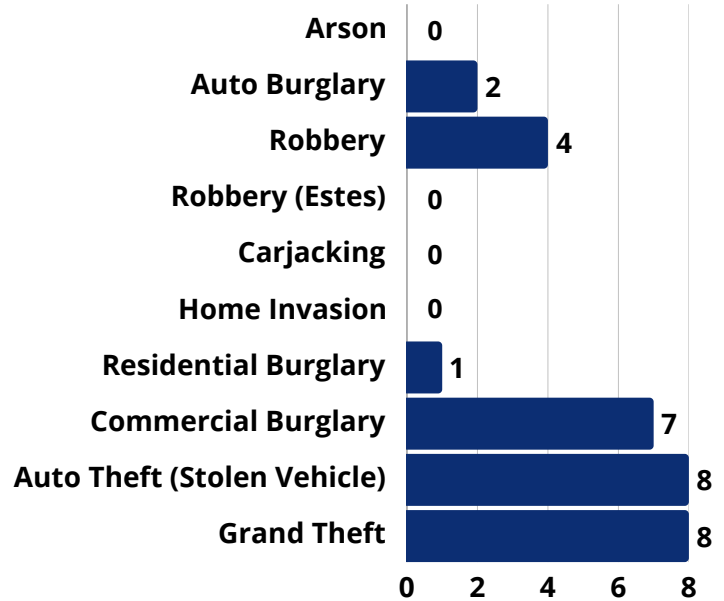




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Evading a Peace Officer

On 8/2, officers responded to a disturbance at an auto repair shop on Thornton Ave. A customer's husband (subject) threatened the shop owner (victim) with a golf club. The subject fled in a vehicle. An officer located the subject's vehicle on Fremont Blvd and attempted to initiate a traffic stop, but the subject drove away at a high speed, violating several vehicle codes. The officer responded to the vehicle's registered address to conduct a security check and found the subject walking in a nearby parking lot. The subject was placed under arrest. #250802015

## Indecent Exposure

On 7/30, officers responded to a report of indecent exposure near Grimmer Blvd and High St. The victim was sitting in her parked vehicle when a subject approached her and exposed himself, then masturbated in front of her. The subject fled on foot, but officers located the subject nearby. Officers found the subject was in possession of methamphetamine. The subject was placed under arrest. #250730006

On 7/31, officers responded to a report of indecent exposure at an apartment complex on Darwin Dr. A subject was nude and masturbating in front of one of the apartments, where the victim and her young child live. Officers arrived and placed the subject under arrest. #250731028

## Robbery

On 7/29, officers responded to a robbery at a grocery store on Argonaut Way. A subject opened food items and ate them, then attempted to walk out of the store with merchandise. When the manager (victim) attempted to intervene, the subject threw frozen food at him, hitting him in the face. The subject also threatened to stab the victim. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. #250729020

On 8/1, officers responded to a report of a strongarm robbery near Central Ave and Fremont Blvd. The victim was sitting on the curb when her roommate (subject) walked up behind her, pulled her hair, and beat her. The subject took the victim's wallet and fled. The wallet was later recovered. This case remains under investigation. #250801004

## Swatting

On 8/4, officers responded to a residence regarding a subject on Ronda Ct who claimed to have killed his friend. The subject said he was considering committing suicide and had another friend tied up at the residence. Officers surrounded the residence, and two residents exited the home without incident. Officers cleared the residence and found no signs of threat or crime inside. The subject who generated the swatting call may have obtained the residents' information from a gaming platform. #250804020
