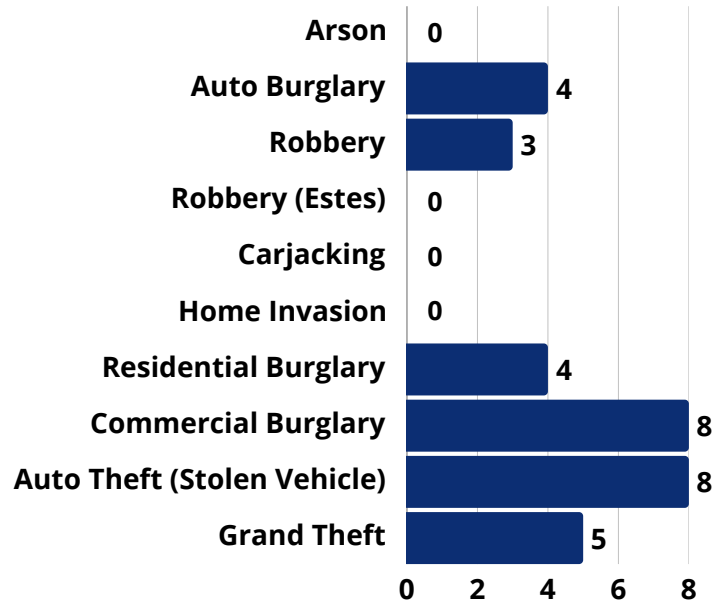

Criminal Threats

On 8/10, officers responded to a subject who stole a grocery store display rack on Argonaut Way. The store manager was driving home when he saw the subject walking nearby with the rack. When employees asked the subject to return it, the subject threatened to stab them. Officers located the subject and placed her under arrest. #250810010

Elder Abuse

On 8/7, officers investigated a financial elder abuse incident at an assisted living facility on Walnut Ave. An employee (subject) stole cash and jewelry from several elderly residents over the course of her employment. Officers recovered multiple pieces of jewelry from the subject's home. The subject was placed under arrest. #250807017

Follow-Up

On 8/7, officers followed up on a road rage incident in which a subject cut a victim off while driving, then brandished a firearm at him. With the help of the Major Crimes Task Force (MCTF), Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), and General Property Crimes (GEN), officers identified the subject and authored a search warrant for the subject's address. Upon searching the residence, officers found methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, and items commonly used for drug sales. The subject was placed under arrest. #250730017

Grand Theft

On 8/7, officers responded to a report of grand theft at a bank on Beacon Ave. A victim withdrew approximately \$4,000 and placed it in an envelope in her purse. After the victim entered her vehicle, a subject told the victim she had dropped her envelope. The victim went to look, did not see an envelope, and drove away. When she arrived home, the envelope in her purse was missing. #250807015

Invasion of Privacy

On 8/11, a victim reported an invasion of privacy at an apartment on Darwin Dr. The victim had stepped out of the shower when she noticed a phone camera pointed at her through the bathroom window. The victim yelled at the subject holding the phone, and the subject fled on foot. The investigation revealed that the subject was a resident of the apartment complex. Officers contacted the subject and placed him under arrest. #250811014

Shots Fired

On 8/12, at approximately 10:15 p.m., officers responded to a shooting in the area of Jacinto Dr, near Cabrillo Trail Park. Officers arrived quickly and found bullet casings on the ground. Witnesses advised that several vehicles were chasing each other in the neighborhood and exchanged gunfire on Cabrillo Ave. One bystander was hit by a stray bullet in the Cabrillo area. The victim was treated for non-life-threatening injuries and transported to the hospital by paramedics. This investigation remains active. #250812014

Vandalism

On 8/8, officers responded to a vandalism incident at a restaurant on Christy St. A subject threw a large rock through the restaurant's windows, then used a pair of pliers to threaten others in the area. The subject fled on foot before officers arrived. #250808017
