## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 8/19, officers responded to a disturbance at an apartment complex on Paseo Padre Pkwy. Two individuals were in the parking lot when a victim approached and asked them for a ride. As the two individuals were discussing, the victim shouted rude comments at them. One subject retrieved a metal pipe from his vehicle and struck the victim with it multiple times. The assailant was placed under arrest. #250819001

## Auto Burglary

On 8/25, officers responded to a report of an in-progress auto burglary at an apartment complex on Monroe Ave. The reporting party saw several subjects using tools to attempt to force open a vehicle. When officers arrived, they located a juvenile subject crouching near a vehicle. Upon seeing the officers' patrol vehicle, the subject fled on foot, but was apprehended after a short pursuit. The subject was released to a family member and issued a notice to appear. #250825005

## Battery

On 8/21, officers responded to a report of battery near Stevenson Blvd and Blacow Rd. A victim was walking home from a nearby liquor store when two subjects approached him from behind. The subjects beat the victim, causing significant injuries. The subjects fled, and the victim walked home prior to reporting it to the police. #250821002

## Criminal Threats

On 8/21, officers responded to a disturbance on Irvington Ave. A subject walked up to two individuals, then attempted to strike one of them with a crowbar. The subject yelled at them, then returned to his vehicle. Officers contacted the subject, who said he was attempting to intimidate them for speaking too loudly. ## Petty Theft

On 8/23, officers responded to a theft report at a cell phone store on Fremont Blvd. A subject cut the security cord from one of the display tablets, concealed the tablet in his pants, and left the store. The subject also poured lighter fluid on some debris outside the store and unsuccessfully attempted to light it on fire. The subject fled across the street and was located and detained nearby. The subject was placed under arrest. #250823012

On 8/24, officers responded to a vehicle rental company on Osgood Ct. The owner saw a subject attempting to siphon gasoline from one of the company's trucks. Officers arrived and located the subject at the scene. The subject was placed under arrest. #250824003

## Robbery

On 8/22, officers responded to a robbery at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. An employee saw a subject placing miscellaneous items inside a backpack. The employee attempted to stop the subject, who pushed the employee and spat on him before fleeing on foot. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. #250822014

On 8/21, officers responded to a report of shoplifting at a hardware store on Ice House Ter. A loss prevention employee saw the subject concealing approximately \$200 worth of tools from the store. Security detained him at the exit when the subject attempted to leave the store with the items. The subject was placed under arrest. #250821015

On 8/24, officers responded to a disturbance at an auto repair shop on Peralta Ave. A subject was attempting to pick up a vehicle that was not registered to him. Area law enforcement agencies advised FPD officers that the subject had an active homicide warrant from another state. The subject was placed under arrest. #250824015
