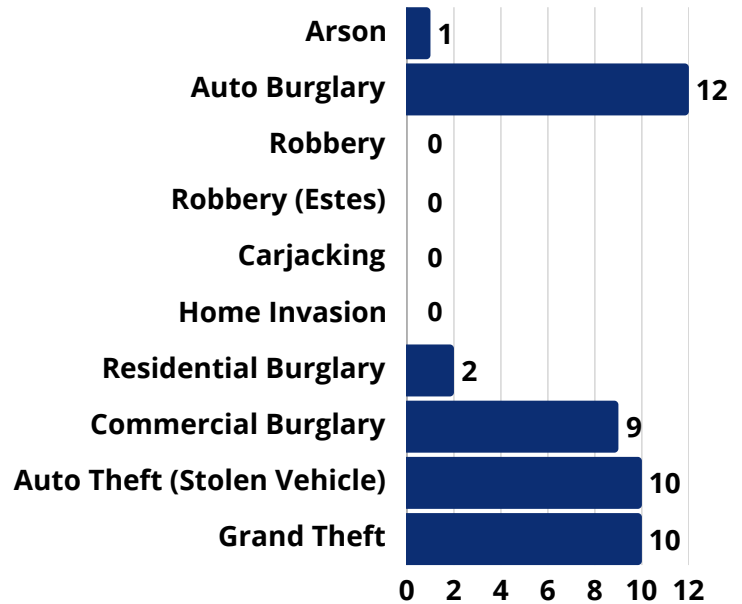

Arson

On 8/18, officers responded to an arson at a restaurant on Thornton Ave. The restaurant's outdoor umbrella and table were on fire, and a subject was throwing substances into the flames. Fremont Fire Department responded to extinguish the fire. When officers responded, the subject spontaneously confessed to the arson multiple times. The subject was placed under arrest. #250818035

Battery

On 8/15, an officer responded to a battery at a hospital on Mowry Ave. A discharged patient (subject) refused to leave unless he was given a ride to a convenience store or a shelter. The subject spat on a nurse and struck another nurse. The subject was placed under arrest. #250815002

On 8/15, officers responded to a report of criminal threats at a hotel on Farwell Dr. The victim heard loud music coming from the subject's room and asked the subject to turn it down. The subject brandished a tennis racket at the victim, then threatened to kill him. The subject also had an outstanding warrant and was on active probation. The victim and his wife (subject) were arguing when the subject used a pair of scissors to stab the victim. Officers responded to their residence and placed the subject under arrest. #250813004

Evading Arrest

On 8/14, an officer was patrolling near San Pedro Dr and Frobisher Dr when he noticed two vehicles that appeared to be racing. The vehicles were driving at a high rate of speed and failed to stop at a stop sign in a school zone. One vehicle yielded to a traffic stop, but the second sped away. Another law enforcement agency located the second vehicle in a nearby city, finding a juvenile driving it. The juvenile was cited and issued a notice to appear. #250814031
