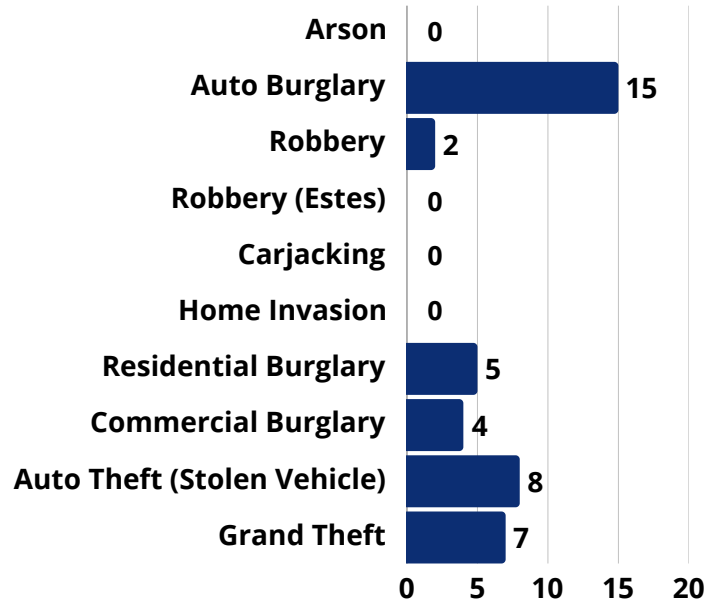

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 8/31, officers responded to an assault with a deadly weapon at an apartment complex on Bright Common. A subject driving a vehicle was yelling at some children playing outside. An adult victim approached to defend the children. The victim stood in front of the subject's vehicle, and the subject drove forward. The victim jumped onto the vehicle's hood, and the subject drove off with the victim hanging off the vehicle. The subject fled before officers arrived, but officers ultimately contacted her at her residence. The subject was placed under arrest. #250831020

Battery

On 8/29, officers responded to a disturbance near Stevenson Blvd and Liberty St. A subject set multiple small fires in the area, then began hitting his head on a streetlight. Officers contacted the subject, who was yelling and jumping up and down on Sundale Ave. When officers attempted to detain him, the subject was belligerent and spat at the officers. Officers subdued the subject and placed him under arrest. #250829001

Burglary

On 8/26, officers responded to a residential burglary on Mowry Ave. The suspect was still inside the residence when officers arrived. The suspect cooperated with police and was escorted out. During the investigation, officers discovered the suspect had stolen items and used a stolen credit card from the home to purchase groceries. Afterward, the subject returned to the residence with the groceries. The subject was placed under arrest. #250826014

On 9/1, officers responded to a request for assistance from campus law enforcement at a college on Mission Blvd. A subject broke a window and entered a classroom. Officers set up containment and located the subject, hiding in a bathtub. The subject was placed under arrest. #250901016

Grand Theft

Between 8/20 and 8/29, a shipping center on Cushing Pkwy reported seizing multiple packages, each containing several thousand dollars in cash. The packages were part of a phone scam, in which elderly fraud victims were instructed to send cash to a local address, which they mistakenly believed to be the address of the U.S. Treasury. The victims were told their private information would be leaked, their bank account had been hacked, or that they were the focus of a criminal investigation where payment was necessary. Detectives observed a subject retrieve delivered packages and placed him under arrest. #250829028

Indecent Exposure

On 8/27, officers responded to reports of a topless female subject in the area of Hastings St and Mowry Ave. The subject was contacted but was unable to answer the officers' questions. The subject had an outstanding warrant and was placed under arrest. #250827019

Stolen Vehicle

On 8/26, officers were alerted to a stolen vehicle near Fremont Blvd and Washington Blvd. When officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop, the driver (subject) exited the vehicle, fled on foot, and then jumped the fence of a residence. Officers set up a perimeter but were unable to locate the suspect. This case remains under investigation. #250826018

Theft

On 8/31, officers responded to a report of theft at a department store on Fremont Blvd. A subject took clothes from the store into a fitting room and changed into them. He took miscellaneous other items and exited the building without paying. Officers located the subject at a nearby café and placed him under arrest. #250831015
