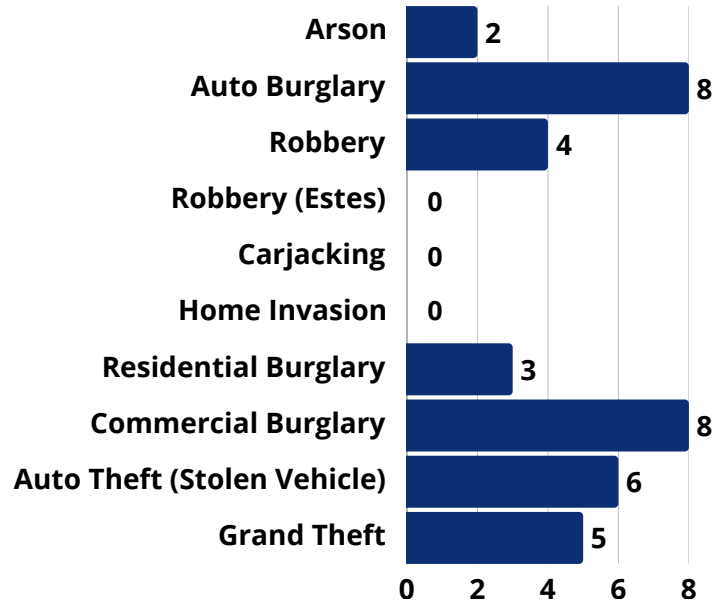




Fremont Police Week In Review

Brandishing a Weapon

On 9/9, officers responded to a report of gun brandishing in the parking lot of a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. A victim saw a subject standing near a parked car and asked the subject if he could take his parking spot. The subject yelled at the victim and retrieved what looked like a handgun from his vehicle. The subject appeared to cock the handgun, and the victim fled. The subject was located and placed under arrest. The item that appeared to be a handgun was discovered to be a cigarette holder shaped like a handgun. #250909022

On 9/10, officers responded to a disturbance on Manitoba Green, in which a victim heard screaming from his neighbor's residence and saw a subject in the backyard holding a knife. When the victim approached, the subject lunged at him with the knife. The subject then jumped a fence onto Auto Mall Pkwy and later entered an elementary school campus. Officers located the subject on a nearby street and placed him under arrest. #250910015

Concealed Carry of a Dirk or Dagger

On 9/12, officers responded to a disturbance near Fremont Blvd and Sundale Ave. Several callers reported a subject carrying an axe and standing on the side of the road. When officers arrived, they located the subject with an axe concealed in his waistband. The subject also had methamphetamines and drug paraphernalia on his person. He was placed under arrest. #250912010

Fremont Municipal Code Violation

On 9/13, officers responded to a report of a shooting at an apartment complex on Stevenson Blvd. The reporting party heard a gunshot, and a round shattered his sliding door. Another resident told officers he was cleaning his rifle and had accidentally discharged it. The accidental discharge was determined to be a violation of Fremont Municipal Code. #250913019

Mental Health Hold

On 9/12, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence on Madison Cmn. A subject was nude, throwing items at passing vehicles and running through the street. When officers arrived, the subject retreated into her residence. Officers negotiated with the subject from outside for two hours, but she remained uncooperative. Eventually, the subject exited the residence and yelled incoherently at officers. While outside the residence, the subject was detained and placed on a mental health hold. #250912024

Mental Health Hold

On 9/15, dispatch received a call from a subject who said they were headed to a factory on Fremont Blvd to commit a shooting. Officers immediately deployed to the factory and coordinated with the facility's security to secure the location. The reporting party's phone number texted dispatch to advise that they were with the subject on a bus headed to Fremont. The subject had borrowed the phone to call dispatch and warn of the threat. Officers located the subject on the bus, finding her without a firearm. The subject admitted to hearing voices that told her to commit a shooting at the factory. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #250915001

Prowling

On 9/13, officers responded to a report of an active residential burglary on Euclid Pl. A subject jumped the backyard fence and was peering into the house through the sliding glass door. When officers arrived, they found her hiding in a bush in a nearby open lot. The subject was placed under arrest. #250913020

Robbery

On 9/10, officers responded to a robbery in the parking lot of a bank on Christy St. A victim and his girlfriend were having lunch when a subject approached in a vehicle and demanded they give him their bag. The subject reached toward his hip, where he had what appeared to be a firearm. The subject took the bag and drove away. This case remains under investigation. #250910030

Unlawful Fire

On 9/10, officers responded to an unlawful fire near Mowry Ave and Hastings St. A subject lit a bush on fire, adjacent to a building. Upon arrival, officers extinguished the fire and located the responsible subject. The subject was placed under arrest. #250910036

Vandalism

On 9/10, officers responded to a vandalism incident at a shopping center on Fremont Blvd. A subject threw a bottle through a window and was yelling to himself. The subject was placed under arrest. #250910006

On 9/14, officers responded to a report of a subject operating an e-bike recklessly near Fremont Blvd and Mowry Ave, aggressively weaving through traffic, striking vehicles, and creating a dangerous situation for both drivers and pedestrians. Officers quickly apprehended the subject, who was subsequently placed under arrest. Fremont Fire Department, along with emergency medical services, evaluated the individual to ensure their well-being. This incident highlights the importance of safe and responsible behavior while using e-bikes on public roadways. #250914021
