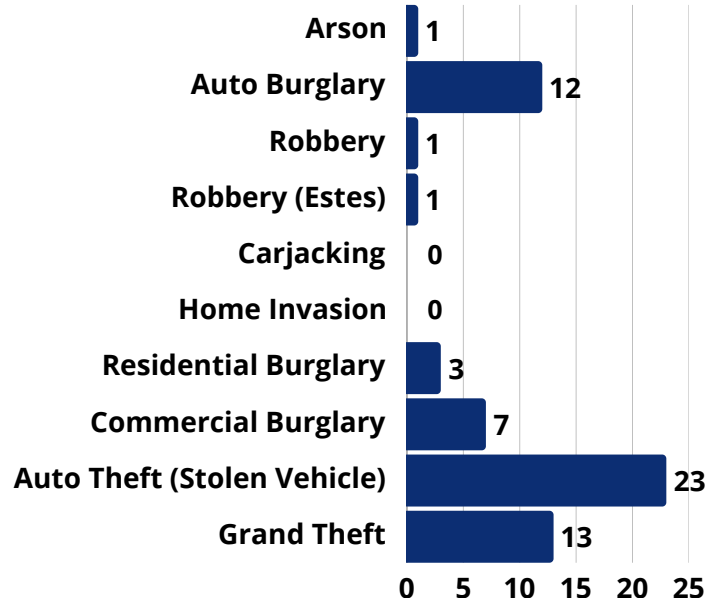

Brandishing a Weapon

On 10/2, officers responded to a report of a subject who brandished a machete at a victim outside a hotel on Fremont Blvd. The subject was upset at the victim for letting his dogs relieve themselves in the bushes. The subject retrieved a long knife and threatened to stab both the victim and his dogs. The knife was located at the scene, and the subject was placed under arrest. #251002016

Criminal Threats

On 10/4, a subject with a machete threatened an employee at a grocery store on Mowry Ave. Officers located the subject, who provided false identifying information and was in possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Officers also discovered the subject had multiple outstanding warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #251004012

Concealed Carry of a Firearm

On 10/2, officers conducted a traffic enforcement stop for expired registration on Fremont Blvd. While conducting the stop, the officer observed a loaded pistol magazine behind the driver's seat and a semiautomatic pistol in the center console. The subject was placed under arrest. The magazine and pistol were confiscated and booked into evidence. #251003002

Miscellaneous Public Service

On 10/6, an officer responded to a van on fire near Maple St and Peralta Blvd. Officers confirmed the van was unoccupied, and the Fremont Fire Department extinguished the fire. The owner of the vehicle said he may have left a lit cigarette in the van accidentally. #251006004

Possession of Marijuana for Sale

On 10/6, an officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a vehicle driving erratically near Eggers Dr and Mayfield Dr. The driver (subject) was found to be on active probation, and a search of his vehicle yielded a large amount of marijuana and a replica pellet rifle. Residential Burglary

On 10/2, a resident reported an in-progress residential burglary on Granville Dr. The victim homeowner was watching live surveillance video of subjects who broke into the residence through a backyard sliding door. Officers arrived promptly to set up a perimeter and clear the residence, but the subjects fled prior to police arrival. This case remains under investigation. #251001044

On 10/3, officers responded to a residential burglary on Japala Pl. The victim said several items were stolen from his room. The victim arrived home to find his rear sliding glass door open with scratch marks and drag marks on the porch. #251003030

Robbery

On 10/3, officers responded to a robbery at a bank on Mission Blvd. Officers found the subjects fleeing in a vehicle on I-880 north. The vehicle was stopped in a nearby city, and four subjects were placed under arrest after a brief foot pursuit. The stolen property was recovered. #251003013

Shoplifting

On 10/5, officers responded to a department store on Fremont Blvd after store security reported two subjects had taken merchandise without paying for it. As officers arrived, the suspects fled on foot, and one was detained nearby. The other ran into an apartment complex and was found hiding in a garbage enclosure. Both subjects were placed under arrest. #251005022

Violation of a Protective Order

On 9/30, officers responded to reports of battery in a parking lot on Stevenson Blvd. Reporting parties said a subject struck a victim and shoved them into a vehicle. Officers later located the vehicle and stopped it, finding that the victim had a restraining order against the subject. Officers also found the subject in possession of methamphetamine. The subject was placed under arrest. #250930025
