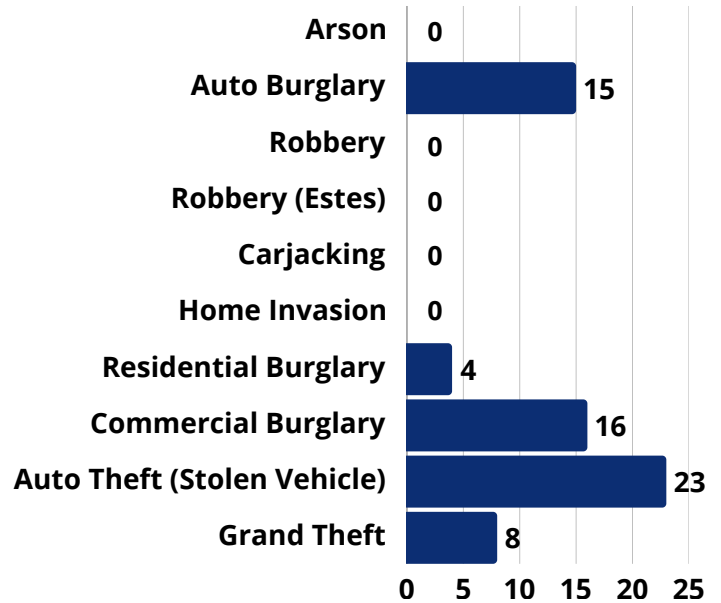

Assault on an Officer

On 10/17, officers responded to the area of Nobel Dr regarding a subject threatening to vandalize businesses in the area. Officers located the subject driving on I-880 South and initiated a traffic stop. Upon contact, the subject threw a tire iron at officers and charged them with a knife. Officers overcame the resistance and then placed the subject into custody. After being medically cleared, the subject was placed under arrest. #251017026

Battery

On 10/14, officers responded to multiple reports of battery near Bay St and Grimmer Blvd. FPD's Real-Time Intelligence Center revealed that one subject was holding a large knife. Officers arrived and found three juveniles involved in a fight. All three juveniles were detained and admonished before being released to their parents. #251014027

On 10/15, officers responded to a report of battery at a fast-food restaurant on Ardenwood Blvd. A subject slashed a victim with a machete, causing a large laceration in the victim's hand. The subject was located nearby and placed under arrest. #251015024

Commercial Burglary

On 10/20, officers responded to a burglary alarm at a restaurant on Boscell Rd. Upon arrival, officers saw a vehicle flee at a high rate of speed. Officers discovered that eight businesses in the same area had been burglarized. Injury Collision

On 10/18, officers responded to a collision involving a passenger vehicle and a commercial truck near Auto Mall Pkwy and Grimmer Blvd. The driver reported that his vehicle was stuck underneath the commercial truck trailer. Officers responded with the Fremont Fire Department and extracted the driver, who had minor visible injuries. #251018001

Petty Theft

On 10/19, officers responded to a report of shoplifting at a department store on Fremont Blvd. Loss prevention said the subject stole multiple items, then walked out of the rear door. Officers located the suspect in a nearby breezeway, in possession of the stolen items and drug paraphernalia. The subject was placed under arrest. #251019009

Receiving Stolen Property

On 10/16, officers responded to a report of theft at a residence on Bidwell Dr. The victim said her earbuds were pinging to the residence, and her credit cards had been used for fraudulent online purchases delivered to the same address. Officers contacted a subject at the residence and found the victim's property in the subject's bag. The subject also had drug paraphernalia and property from several other victims in the bag. The subject was placed under arrest. #251016019

Residential Burglary

On 10/18, residents returned to their home on Southerland Way to find two subjects burglarizing the residence. The subjects fled into an open field behind the house before officers arrived. Officers searched the area but did not find the subjects. This case remains under investigation. #251018022

Stolen Vehicle

On 10/20, officers responded to a report of a stolen vehicle from Argyle Rd. The victim said he heard the vehicle being driven away only a few minutes before he reported the incident. Officers located the vehicle unoccupied but still running at Jason Way and Parish Ave. The vehicle was recovered and returned to the victim. #251020009

Warrant Service

On 10/15, a reporting party flagged an officer near Brown Rd. The reporting party said he located a subject he believed was responsible for a theft at his business. Officers contacted the subject and found he had an outstanding warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #251015015

On 10/20, officers responded to a report of burglary at a residence on Old Canyon Rd. A subject attempted to open a vehicle in the driveway, then jumped the fence into the backyard. The subject fled in a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle nearby and conducted a traffic stop, detaining multiple subjects found in the vehicle. One subject was found to have an outstanding warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #251020008
