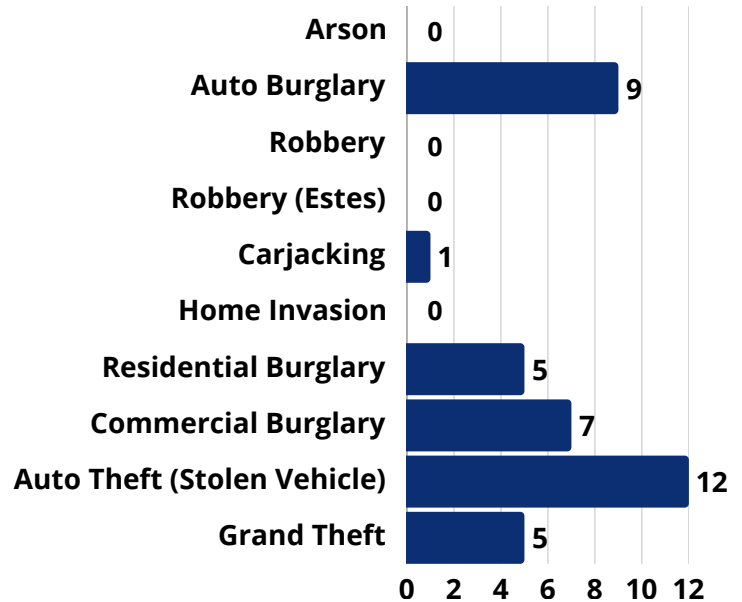

Assault on an Officer with a Weapon

On 10/22, FPD's Investigations Unit located a vehicle involved in several commercial burglaries of businesses and temples in Fremont and other Bay Area cities. The vehicle was in a neighboring city and had a stolen license plate attached to it. The vehicle was stopped at a car wash. When detectives attempted to apprehend the subject, she entered her vehicle and rammed it into the detectives' vehicles several times. Detectives used a less lethal projectile to shatter the rear windshield, and the subject fled on foot. Detectives apprehended the subject and placed her under arrest. The subject was not struck by the projectile #250924004, #250924005, #250924007 and #251022011

Commercial Burglary

On 10/23, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a liquor store on Thornton Ave. Four subjects cut the lock box off the business's front door, then left the scene. The subjects returned later with what appeared to be the key from the lock box. The subjects attempted to steal an electronic kiosk and the cash register's contents, but were unsuccessful. The subjects fled in a vehicle. #251023001

On 10/27, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a warehouse on Albrae St. Four subjects broke into the warehouse and stole several marijuana plants. The subjects left other large and small marijuana plants behind, which were illegally cultivated. Officers have yet to locate anyone responsible for the business, and the Fremont Fire Department red-tagged the business. Officers confiscated the plants, and a board-up company secured the building. #251027001

False Imprisonment

On 10/23, officers responded to a report of false imprisonment at an apartment on Guardino Dr. A victim texted 911 to report that her husband (subject) was forcing her to remain inside and unclothed. He threatened to harm her, her unborn child, and their animals. Officers arrived promptly, finding the subject nude inside the apartment with the victim. The subject was also in violation of an emergency protective order, restraining him from the victim. The subject was placed under arrest. #251023004

Fraud

On 10/27, an officer responded to a report of forgery at a credit union on Mowry Ave. A customer (subject) deposited four fraudulent checks, with a loss of approximately \$30,000. The checks had been "washed" to remove the payee information and to insert the subject's name fraudulently. An employee at the credit union provided officers with identifying information for the subject. This case remains under investigation. #251027013

Injury Collision

On 10/23, an officer investigated a collision on Mission Blvd near Gurdwara Rd. A vehicle struck a mailbox and overturned, injuring the passengers inside. #251023003

Outside Assist

On 10/26, officers provided outside assistance to a nearby Police Department for a vehicle pursuit, during which the suspect vehicle traveled to Fremont. The suspect vehicle was eventually stopped on Stevenson Blvd, and the driver (subject) was taken into custody. #251026001

Recovered Stolen Vehicle

On 10/25, officers responded to a report of a vehicle with no license plates being dumped by three subjects on Overacker Dr. Officers arrived and discovered that the vehicle was an unreported stolen vehicle from another city. Officers advised the law enforcement agency for that city and released the vehicle to the owner. #251025011

Suspicious Fire

On 10/21, officers responded to an outside assist with the Fremont Fire Department at an apartment complex on Stevenson Blvd. FFD advised of a suspicious fire originating from plants in the third-floor lobby. An unknown material was at the base of one plant. It is unknown whether the fire was set intentionally, and no subjects were located. #251021028

Violation of Protective Order

On 10/26, officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at a residence on 3rd St, in which a subject was captured on surveillance cameras looking through the windows. Officers arrived and located the subject, who was the reporting party's (victim) ex-wife. The subject had a criminal protective order, restraining the subject from the victim's residence. The subject was placed under arrest. #251026005
