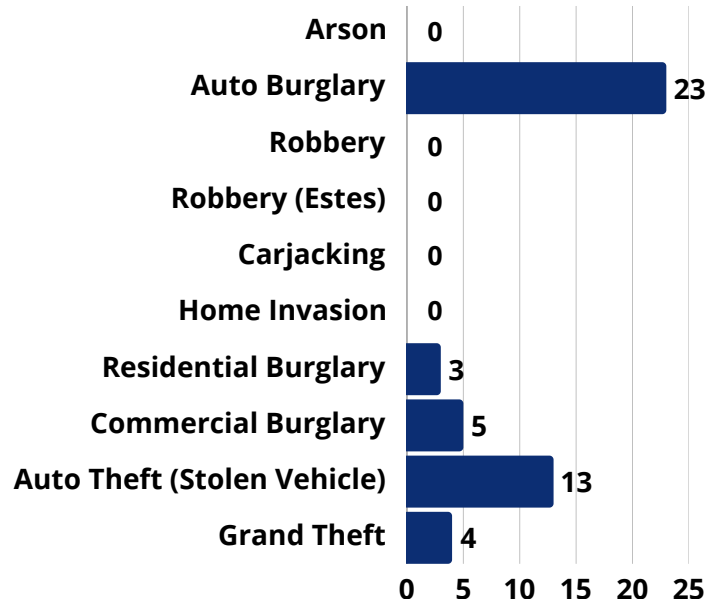




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Auto Burglary

On 10/29, officers responded to an auto burglary at a gym on Farwell Dr. A reporting party saw multiple subjects smash a vehicle's windows and remove a backpack from the interior. The subjects fled in a vehicle. FPD's Real Time Information Center (RTIC) located the subject vehicle, and officers followed it throughout the East Bay. With the assistance of General Property Crimes (GEN), Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), Major Crimes Task Force (MCTF), and other agencies, the subjects were contacted in another city. One subject was placed under arrest. #251029012

## Battery On A Peace Officer

On 10/28, officers responded to a report of a subject harassing drivers and workers near Paseo Padre Parkway and Capitol Avenue. The subject was jumping in front of vehicles and hitting vehicle windows. When contacted, the subject slapped an officer's hand and appeared to be intoxicated. The subject was placed under arrest. #251028018

## Battery/Trespassing

On 11/3, officers responded to a battery at a furniture store on Boscell Rd. A subject was sleeping on display furniture when the store manager (victim) asked him to leave. The suspect became hostile and struck the victim in the face before fleeing toward the alley behind the store. Officers contacted the subject, finding him intoxicated. The subject was placed under arrest. #251103028

## Brandishing a Firearm

On 11/1, officers responded to a report of brandishing at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. A security guard saw a vehicle drive up with two subjects inside, looking at him. When the security guard asked if they needed assistance, one subject showed a handgun, then sped away. This case remains under investigation. #251101005

## Commercial Burglary

On 11/2, officers responded to a commercial burglary at an antique shop on Niles Blvd. Upon arrival, officers saw two juvenile subjects striking the rear door with an object. Both subjects were detained and issued a notice to appear before being released to their respective parents. #251102004

## Mental Health Hold

On 11/1, officers responded to a residence on Ashford Way for a welfare check on a subject who was asking neighbors to feed her 1-year-old child. The subject was placed on a mental health hold, and the child was safely placed with another family member. #251101018

## Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 10/28, officers responded to a report of a subject armed with a kitchen knife near Central Ave and Fremont Blvd. The suspect was stabbing a chair and walking in the roadway near two schools while children were walking to school. Officers contacted the subject, finding drug paraphernalia. The subject was also on probation. The subject was placed under arrest. #251028003

## Side Show Activity

On 10/27, officers responded to a report of several vehicles meeting up in a parking lot on Albrae St. Upon arrival, officers discovered approximately 150 to 200 cars gathered in the area. Officers contacted the organizer of the gathering and facilitated a safe exit of all vehicles out of the area. #P25116959

## Stolen Vehicle

On 10/30, detectives from General Property Crimes (GEN), Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), and the Major Crimes Task Force (MCTF) located a stolen vehicle leaving a shopping center on Fremont Blvd. The vehicle had been reported stolen from an apartment complex on Wellman Terrace earlier that day. Detectives followed the vehicle to a shopping center in a nearby city, where two subjects exited the vehicle and walked into a hardware store. When they returned, detectives contacted and arrested two subjects. One of the subjects was in possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Both subjects were placed under arrest. #251030004

## Unlawful Firearm Possession

On 10/30, an officer observed a vehicle stopped in the roadway, obstructing traffic near Fremont Blvd and Enea Ct. While contacting the driver (subject), the officer noticed a handgun magazine near the driver's feet. A search revealed the driver had a firearm concealed on his person and a variety of narcotics. The subject was placed under arrest. #251030027
