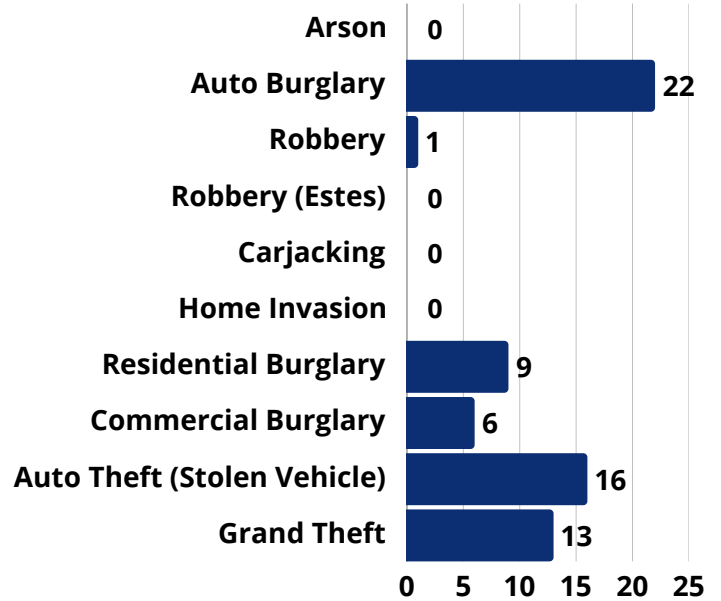

Armed Robbery

On 11/4, officers responded to an armed robbery at a convenience store on Mowry Ave. One subject pointed a handgun at the clerk (victim), and another jumped over the counter. The subjects stole cigarettes and money from the cash register, then fled on foot. This case remains under investigation. #251104001

Attempted Vehicle Theft

On 11/7, a victim reported an attempted vehicle theft at a residence on Porter St. Two juvenile subjects broke into the vehicle and rummaged through the items inside. Officers located the subjects nearby and placed them under arrest. Both subjects were issued a notice to appear and released to a family member. #251107002 and #251107003

Battery

On 11/7, officers responded to a report of battery at a federal benefits office on Mowry Ave, in which a subject was being verbally aggressive toward the staff. As the security guard was escorting the subject out, the subject struck the security guard several times. Officers arrived to find the two still involved in a physical altercation outside the building. The subject was placed under arrest. #251107022

Commercial Burglary

On 11/7, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a swim club on Las Palmas Ave. A subject stole the master key from the lock box, and surveillance footage revealed that the subject had stayed in the building overnight. Officers arrived and established a containment area around the building. The subject surrendered and exited the building, and officers placed him under arrest. #251107028

Residential Burglary

On 11/8, officers responded to a burglary at a residence on Ariel Ave. The victim returned home to find two subjects who ran out of his backyard and fled in a vehicle. A search of the residence revealed the subjects had likely entered through the windows and had stolen approximately \$24,000 worth of jewelry and other items. This case remains under investigation. #251108010

Residential Burglary

On 11/9, officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at a residence on 3rd St, in which a reporting party heard glass breaking in the back of the residence. As officers were searching the residence, a subject ran out of it and hid in front of another residence. After a short pursuit, the subject was apprehended by FPD K9 Duke. The subject had numerous items from the residence in his backpack and had multiple outstanding warrants. The subject was placed under arrest. #251109016

Resisting Arrest

On 11/9, officers attempted to perform a traffic stop on a cyclist (subject) riding on Farwell Dr. The subject ignored officers' commands and fled, abandoning the bicycle at his residence on Coco Palm Dr. The subject ran inside the residence, but officers pursued and detained him without incident. The subject was found to be on probation and had multiple outstanding warrants. The bicycle he was riding had also been reported as a stolen vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest. #251109005

Shoplifting

On 11/7, officers responded to a report of shoplifting at a department store on Pacific Commons Blvd, where the subject left the store with a cart full of unpurchased merchandise. When officers attempted to stop the subject on a nearby street, the subject fled on foot but was detained shortly afterward. The subject was also in possession of drug paraphernalia and a bag of methamphetamine and another controlled substance. The subject was placed under arrest. #251107030

On 11/7, an officer was patrolling near Auto Mall Pkwy and Boscell Rd when a subject ran past him, out of a nearby alcohol store. The officer pursued on foot and detained the subject, finding him with a bottle of alcohol stolen from the store. The subject had hidden another bottle in a bush nearby. The subject was placed under arrest. #251107017

Vandalism

On 11/5, a resident on Lang Ave reported that a subject was tearing Halloween decorations off a neighbor's residence and placing them in a trash can. Officers located the subject at the scene and placed him under arrest. #251105008
