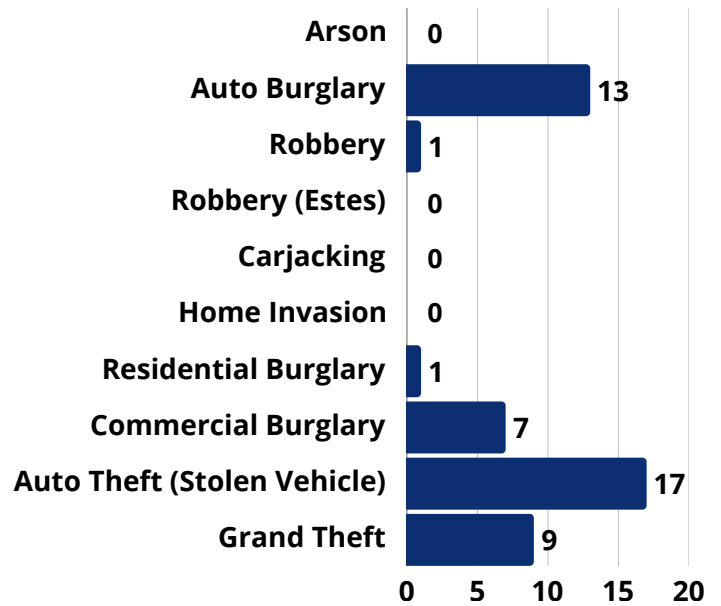

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 11/12, officers responded to multiple reports of an altercation near Walnut Ave and Paseo Padre Pkwy. One subject wrestled a victim to the ground and beat him, then struck the victim in the head with a rock. The subject walked away but was located nearby and placed under arrest. The victim was transported to a medical facility for treatment. #251112022

Attempted Stolen Vehicle

On 11/15, officers responded to an attempted stolen vehicle at a residence on Lake Wawasee St. The victim heard the sound of vehicle doors opening and looked out of her window to see multiple subjects in her driveway. The subjects had shattered the sunroof of the victim's vehicle to gain entry, then fled in multiple vehicles. This case remains under investigation. #251115006

Commercial Burglary

On 11/11, officers responded to a commercial burglary at a plumbing business on Osgood Rd. Multiple subjects rammed a vehicle into the roll-up doors, forcing them open. The subjects stole a large amount of equipment, then fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #251111002

Fraud

On 11/12, officers responded to a report of a cryptocurrency scam. A subject messaged the victim claiming to be from a consulate and warned that the victim had an outstanding warrant due to an ongoing investigation. The subject instructed the victim to transfer funds in the form of cryptocurrency into an online wallet. Shortly afterward, the victim's account was frozen, and her funds were withdrawn from the wallet. #251112031

Injury Collision

On 11/12, officers responded to an injury collision near Fremont Blvd and Tamayo St. Two vehicles were involved in the crash, which caused one of the vehicles to roll over. One occupant sustained a visible injury and was treated at the scene. #251112037

Mental Health Hold

On 9/12, officers responded to a hotel on Fremont Blvd for a welfare check. A subject called 911 more than 40 times within the past day. Officers contacted the subject in her hotel room, and the subject began screaming and yelling obscenities. She refused to cooperate and made statements indicating a desire to harm herself. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #251112005

Possession of a Controlled Substance

On 11/12, officers responded to a disturbance at a convenience store on Grimmer Blvd. A subject was punching the building and yelling outside the store. A search of the subject revealed methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. The subject was placed under arrest. #251112026

Robbery

On 11/12, officers responded to a robbery at a convenience store on Mowry Ave in which multiple subjects stole alcohol from the store. Two employees (victims) followed them outside and attempted to recover the alcohol, but the subjects battered one victim and threatened the other. The subjects fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #251112030

Theft

On 11/13, officers responded to a theft at a drugstore on Paseo Padre Pkwy. A subject laid on the floor in front of a display stand and urinated. He then took several makeup items from the display and concealed them in his pants before leaving the store. Officers found the subject nearby with the stolen items on his person. The subject was placed under arrest. #251113003

Vandalism

On 11/12, officers responded to a burglary at an apartment complex on Farwell Dr. A subject pried open the window screen and entered the community gym. He threatened the manager, then fled the scene on a scooter. Officers found the subject attempting to hide in the side yard of a residence nearby. The subject was placed under arrest. #251112015

On 11/14, officers responded to a report of vandalism at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. A subject placed several pieces of merchandise into a backpack and attempted to leave the store. Upon being confronted by a store employee, the subject exited the store and left the backpack behind. Employees recovered the merchandise, but the subject returned later and broke three of the store windows. The subject fled on a bicycle before officers arrived. #251114014
