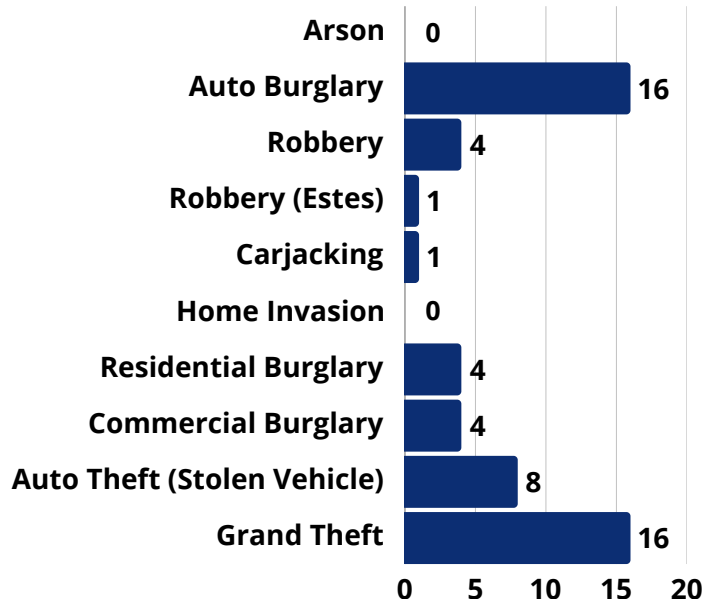




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Battery

On 12/1, officers responded to a battery at a city building on Liberty St. A victim and subject were involved in an argument, and the subject punched the victim in the face. Officers placed the subject under arrest. #251201006

## Domestic Battery

On 11/27, officers responded to a domestic violence incident at an apartment on Mowry Ave. The victim reported that her partner (subject) had slapped her, and the subject claimed the victim had a knife. Officers arrived, contacted both parties, and determined the female had grabbed the knife in an attempt to protect herself from further assault. The male was identified as the dominant aggressor and was placed under arrest. #251127005

On 11/28, officers responded to a domestic violence incident at a residence on Northumberland Ter. The subject pushed the victim into the wall, preventing her from leaving. When the victim walked toward the door, the subject pointed a knife at her. The subject left the scene before officers arrived, but a neighboring law enforcement agency located the subject's vehicle and detained the subject. The subject was placed under arrest. #251128027

## DUI

On 11/27, officers responded to a solo-vehicle collision near Sundale Dr and Wainright Ter. A subject in a vehicle collided with a stop sign, and the front bumper of the vehicle fell off. The subject placed the bumper into his vehicle and fled into a nearby apartment complex. Officers located the subject nearby and found him showing signs of intoxication. The subject was placed under arrest. #251127020

## DUI

On 12/1, officers responded to a solo vehicle collision at Paseo Padre Pkwy and Ardenwood Blvd, where a vehicle struck a pillar supporting solar panels in a high-voltage field. The driver (subject) showed signs of intoxication and was transported to a hospital for medical treatment. The subject was placed under arrest. #251201023

## Theft

On 11/25, officers responded to a report of theft at a clothing store at the Fremont Hub. A subject stole merchandise, and loss prevention personnel from the store had located him nearby. The subject also had two outstanding warrants. The suspect was placed under arrest. #251125017

On 11/26, officers responded to a report of theft at a department store on Fremont Blvd. The store's loss prevention personnel reported a subject concealing electronics and other merchandise in a bag. When officers attempted to contact the subject in the parking lot, he fled on foot. After a brief foot pursuit, officers placed the subject under arrest, and the stolen goods from the store were located inside his bag. The subject also had three outstanding warrants and was on probation. #251126018

On 12/1, officers responded to a report of theft at a department store on Fremont Blvd. A subject concealed several toys in a bag, then left the store. Officers located the subject nearby and placed him under arrest. The stolen toys were found in the subject's backpack and were returned to the store. #251201015

## Residential Burglary

On 11/26, officers responded to a residential burglary at an apartment on Mowry Ave. A subject climbed onto the apartment's rear balcony while the victim was inside the residence. As officers arrived, the subject jumped from the rear balcony and attempted to flee. Officers pursued the subject on foot and apprehended him, then placed him under arrest. #251126002

## Robbery Attempt

On 11/26, officers responded to an attempted robbery at a shopping center on Warm Springs Blvd. An elderly victim was seated in his vehicle when two subjects attempted to remove his necklace forcibly. The victim pulled away before the subjects could take the necklace, and the subjects fled in a vehicle. The Real-Time Information Center quickly located the vehicle leaving the area at a high rate of speed, and the Crime Reduction (CRU) and General Crimes (GEN) Units responded to apprehend the subjects. Both subjects were placed under arrest. #251126008
