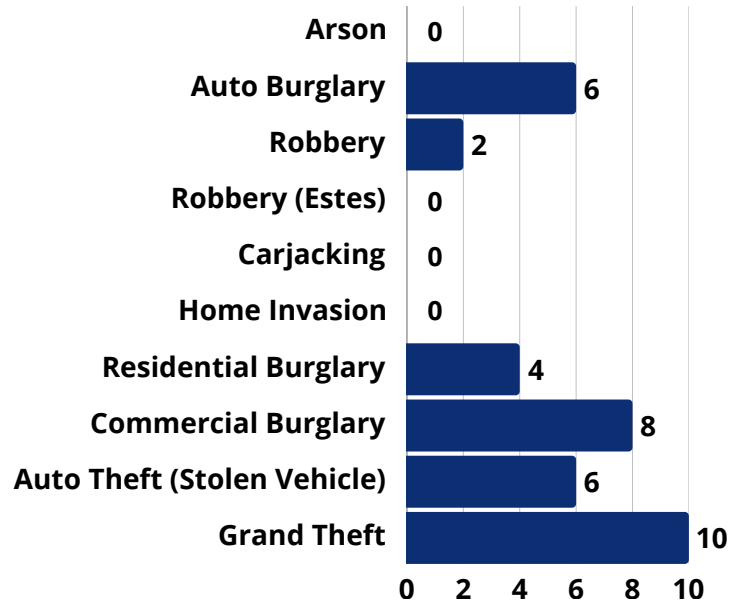

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 12/7, officers responded to a report of assault with a deadly weapon at an apartment on Fremont Blvd. A subject choked his brother (victim) and held a kitchen knife to him. The victim pushed the subject out the door and called 911. Upon arrival, officers determined the victim was uninjured. The subject was placed under arrest. #251207006

DUI

On 12/4, officers responded to a report of an unconscious subject in the driver's seat of a vehicle stopped at Northport Loop East and Cushing Pkwy. The subject had been stopped at the light for 10 minutes, and the vehicle was still running. Officers implemented a public safety block and safely disabled the vehicle. They woke the subject, who was determined to be intoxicated. The subject was placed under arrest. #251204002

Mental Health Hold

On 12/7, officers responded to a disturbance near Peralta Blvd and Fremont Blvd. A subject was running into traffic without pants on, stole a traffic sign, and urinated in the street. When officers made contact, the subject made nonsensical statements and refused to speak with officers. The subject was placed on a mental health hold. #251207008

Package Theft

On 12/5, officers responded to a report of package theft at an apartment complex on Vision Common. Multiple parties reported a subject stealing packages from several floors in the complex. Officers located the subject in a nearby parking lot. The subject was in possession of burglary tools and a passport that was not in her name. Resisting Arrest

On 12/2, an officer observed a subject riding a bicycle in violation of multiple vehicle and municipal codes. When the officer attempted a traffic stop, the subject refused to comply and fled. The subject was apprehended and placed under arrest. #251202043

Resisting Arrest

On 12/7, officers responded to a report of suspicious activity at a residence on Osgood Rd. The resident said a subject was banging on the front door and attempting to open it. Upon contact with officers, the subject attempted to flee on foot, but officers quickly detained him. The subject was placed under arrest.

Residential Burglary

On 12/3, Dispatch received a text from a victim requesting help at a residence on Fremont Blvd. Upon responding, officers discovered the front door had been kicked in, and a subject was in the residence with the victim. As officers detained the subject, he resisted and spat at one officer. The subject was placed under arrest. #251203044

Shots Fired

On 12/7, officers responded to a report of a shooting at an apartment on Fremont Blvd. Multiple parties reported hearing four gunshots in the area. Officers located four shell casings nearby, but no victims or damage were located. #251207002

Sideshow Activity

On 12/5, officers responded to a business on Kato Rd where more than 80 vehicles were gathered in the parking lot engaging in sideshow activities. Officers arrived at the scene, and the vehicles left the area. One of the sideshow vehicles was left abandoned and had a stolen license plate attached to it. The vehicle was towed. #P25131550

Stolen Vehicle

On 12/2, officers responded to a report of a vehicle stolen from a residence on Nylander Ter. The victim said that a week earlier, her son (subject) entered her residence through a window, took the vehicle's keys, and stole the vehicle. The subject initially agreed to return the vehicle but did not, and the victim reported it stolen. This case remains under investigation. #251202045

Warrant Service

On 12/8, officers were in a courthouse in another city when another law enforcement agency advised of a subject with an outstanding warrant for an attempted homicide. Coordinating with the other agency, officers detained the subject without incident. The subject was placed under arrest. #251208006
