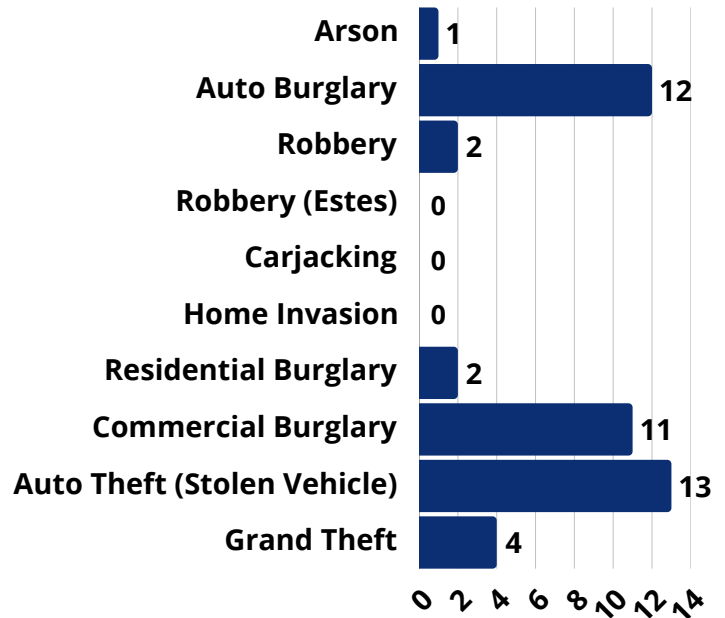

Vehicle Theft Arrest

On 12/9, officers conducted a vehicle theft investigation involving a rental truck obtained using fraudulent identification. The vehicle was later identified through license plate reader technology near Decoto Road and Mission Boulevard. Officers located the vehicle, conducted an investigative stop, and detained the suspect. #251209017

DUI Arrest

On 12/10, Officers responded to the area of Fremont Boulevard and Doane Street regarding a vehicle that collided with a parked vehicle. Upon arrival, officers determined the driver was under the influence of alcohol and was arrested. #251210001

Domestic Battery Arrest

On 12/10, officers responded to the Casa Arroyo Apartments regarding a family battery. The victim reported that her spouse attempted to force her out of the apartment, then grabbed her by the hair. The spouse was determined to be the primary aggressor and was subsequently arrested. #251210025

Hit-and-Run / DUI Arrest

On 12/11, officers responded to a report of a vehicle striking a fire hydrant at Fremont Boulevard and Central Avenue. Witnesses reported that a white truck fled the scene. A community member recorded the incident and identified the driver as a neighbor. Officers located the vehicle and detained the driver, who showed signs of impairment and was arrested for driving under the influence. #251211012

Robbery and Theft

On 12/12, loss prevention at a retail store on Fremont Boulevard reported a female suspect had battered an employee after fleeing the store with merchandise. The suspect vehicle was captured on community cameras, making multiple stops in the area. Officers responded and located the suspect vehicle, unoccupied, in a motel parking lot. The investigation quickly expanded when officers obtained search warrants for both the motel room and the vehicle. Officers detained the occupants of two motel rooms, recovering stolen property. One suspect was arrested for robbery and possession of a controlled substance, and another suspect was cited/arrested for theft. #251212023

Mental Health Hold

On 12/13, officers responded to a residence on Spetti Drive after family members reported that an adult was exhibiting concerning behavior, including hallucinations and threats of harm. Earlier attempts to engage the individual had been unsuccessful, but this time, he voluntarily exited the residence and was safely detained in the backyard. He was placed on a mental health hold, and the situation was resolved without incident. #251213003

Stolen Vehicle / Hit and Run

On 12/14, officers responded to a collision at Fremont Boulevard and Decoto Road, where a vehicle struck another vehicle. Witnesses reported that three occupants of the striking vehicle fled the scene. The driver of the other vehicle was transported to Kaiser Hospital. The striking vehicle was later determined to be stolen, and three potential suspects were located. The investigation is ongoing. #251214001

Possession of Stolen Property

On 12/15, officers conducted a traffic stop on a moped in the area of Central Avenue and Logan Drive. The juvenile driver was found to be in possession of a moped reported stolen earlier this year out of San Francisco. The juvenile was released to a parent. The moped owner was contacted, and the vehicle was towed. #251215018

DUI Collision

On 12/15, a vehicle collided with another vehicle near Mowry Avenue and Cherry Street. The driver of one of the involved vehicles was found to be impaired and was placed under arrest. #251215026
