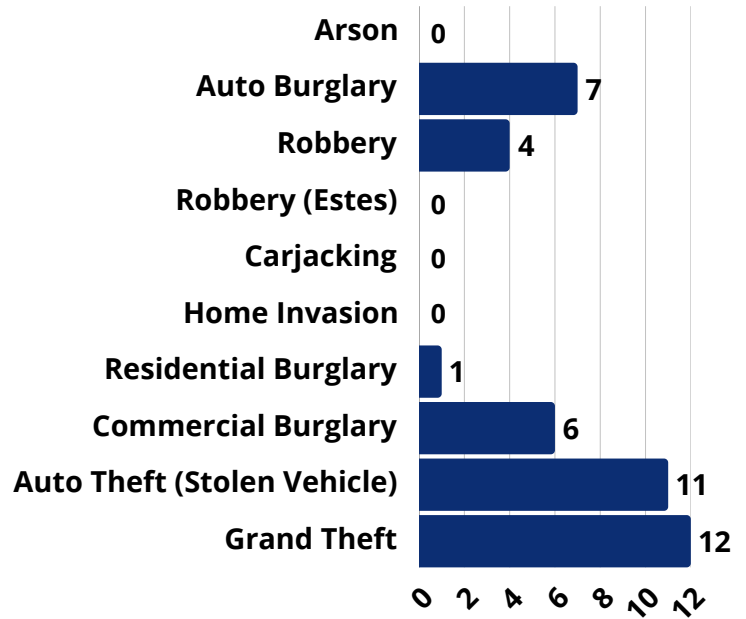




Fremont Police Week In Review

DUI

Mental Health Hold

On 12/30, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence on Gleason Lane. The reporting party said her son (subject) battered her and barricaded himself inside the garage. Officers responded and attempted to contact the subject, but he refused to leave. The subject warned officers that he was in possession of knives, threatening to fight officers and harm himself. After more than three hours of negotiation, the subject continued to be uncooperative, so officers introduced non-lethal projectiles. The subject surrendered and was placed on a mental health hold. #251230013

Residential Burglary

On 1/1, officers responded to a residential burglary at an apartment on Beloveria Ct. The victim returned home to find a subject inside the apartment. When the victim discovered the burglar, the subject fled out the front door. The investigation revealed the subject had entered through the balcony door, ransacked the apartment, and stole items. Robbery

On 12/30, officers responded to a robbery at a gas station convenience store on Mission Blvd. Multiple subjects made entry by shattering the front door of the store. An employee working inside hid in the back room as the subjects stole several thousand dollars' worth of cigarettes. The subjects fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #251230003

Shots Fired

On 1/4, officers responded to a report of shots fired at an apartment on Paseo Padre Pkwy. Officers discovered multiple bullet holes in one unit and found two shell casings near the unit. There were no injured parties found in the building. This case remains under investigation. #260104003

Trespassing/Brandishing a Weapon

On 1/4, officers responded to a residential trailer on King Ave after a reporting party found an unknown subject inside the trailer. The subject brandished a kitchen knife, locked herself inside the trailer, and refused to leave. When officers arrived, they made several announcements and attempted to convince the subject to leave. The subject was uncooperative and barricaded herself inside the trailer. Officers eventually used less-lethal projectiles and a K9 due to her active resistance, and the subject was taken into custody. The subject was medically treated and placed under arrest. #260104007

Violation of a Protective Order

On 1/5, officers responded to a disturbance in an apartment on Fremont Blvd. A subject was breaking items in the residence and harassing family members. Officers determined the subject was in violation of a restraining order and placed him under arrest. #260105019

Warrant Service

On 1/2, officers responded to a trespassing violation at an apartment on Country Dr. A subject was sleeping outside the main entrance and had defecated in the alley, adjacent to a unit. Officers contacted the subject and found she had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. The subject was placed under arrest. #260102017
