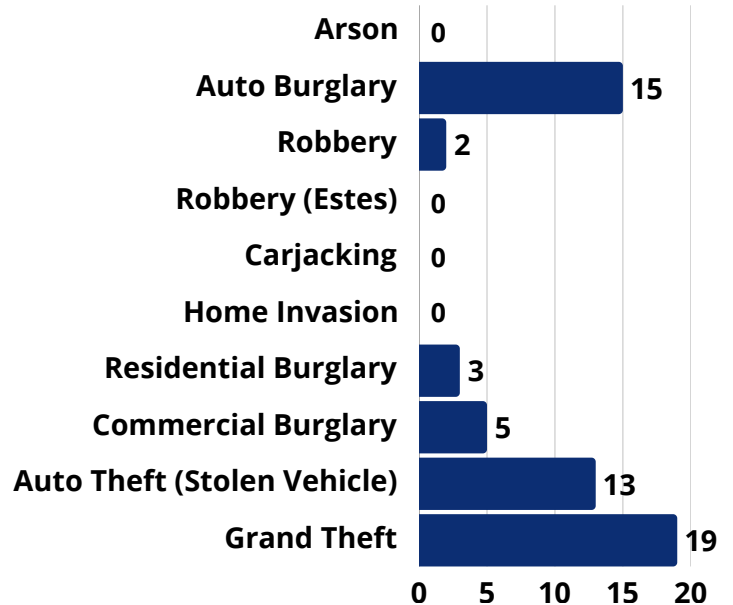




# Fremont Police Week In Review

## Armed Robbery

On 1/6, officers responded to a robbery on Willbridge Terrace. A victim exited his vehicle when a subject armed with a handgun demanded money. The subject took the victim's backpack, then fled in a vehicle. This case remains under investigation. #260106031

## Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 1/7, officers responded to an altercation on Stevenson Blvd. A victim was driving when another driver brake-checked him and swerved into his lane multiple times. The victim pulled into a parking lot, and the other driver (subject) followed, striking the side of the victim's vehicle. The subject drove away momentarily, then rammed his vehicle into the victim's vehicle. The subject fled onto I-880 North, but was later located using community cameras. Officers contacted the subject and placed him under arrest. #260107032

## Brandishing a Weapon

On 1/10, officers responded to a disturbance near Ardenwood Blvd and Ardenwood Terrace. A subject and a victim had a disagreement. The subject subsequently brandished an axe at the victim. The subject had multiple outstanding misdemeanor warrants and possessed methamphetamine. The subject was placed under arrest. #260110019

## Domestic Violence

On 1/9, officers responded to a report of domestic violence at an apartment on Monroe Ave. After a dispute, the victim was strangled by her husband (subject) but remained conscious. Officers obtained an emergency protective order for the victim and placed the subject under arrest. #260109007

## Drunk in Public

On 1/7, officers responded to a report of a subject passed out on the pavement in the parking lot of a hospital on Mowry Ave. The subject was contacted and determined to be intoxicated. She was placed under arrest. #260107019

## DUI

On 1/9, officers responded to a solo vehicle collision at Stevenson Blvd and Blacow Rd. A driver struck the center median and passed out behind the wheel. Officers conducted a public safety block and contacted the driver, who was found to be intoxicated. The subject was placed under arrest. #260109002

## Fraud

On 1/8, officers responded to a fraud report in which the victim lost several thousand dollars. A scammer called and told the victim her account had been compromised. The scam caller connected the victim with another subject, who claimed to be from the victim's bank and directed her to withdraw \$14,000 in cash. The victim gave the money to a courier who arrived at her residence. This case remains under investigation. #260108016

## Trespassing

On 1/11, officers responded to multiple disturbances by the same subject at a grocery store on Fremont Blvd. The subject was pushing shopping carts into customers' vehicles and appeared to be under the influence. The subject was given a trespass warning and released from the scene. Later the same day, the subject returned and punched the store window. The subject was placed under arrest. #260111016
